PROCESSION

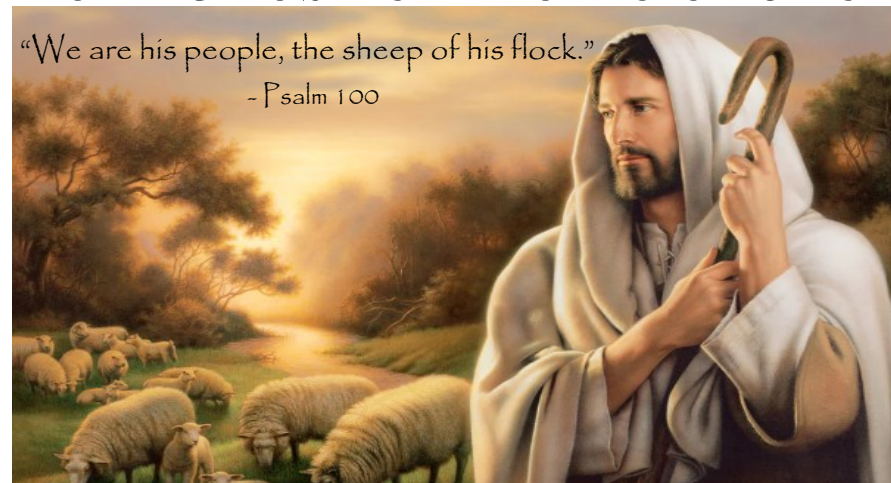
FROM ST. HENRY CHURCH TO REDBUD FESTIVAL PARK

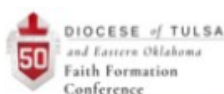

THE HOLY POST

11th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

June 18, 2023

TODAY'S READINGS

FIRST READING: God makes the Israelites a holy nation.

(Exodus 19:2-6a)

PSALM: "We are his people, the sheep of his flock."

(Psalm 100)

SECOND READING: Through Christ we have received reconciliation.

(Romans 5:6-11)

GOSPEL: Jesus summoned the Twelve and sent them out.

(Matthew 9:36 - 10:8)

Running through today's readings is the theme of dedication. In Exodus God dedicates the Chosen People as a holy nation. Paul points out that Christ died for us sinners in the ultimate act of dedication to his formidable mission. In the Gospel, Jesus sends the Twelve out for the first time, instructing them to dedicate themselves to doing all the things they'd seen him do. May today's readings inspire us to dedicate ourselves in the same way, listening prayerfully so we may discern how He is calling us.
