Welcome to our parish! Registration forms are available in each entrance to complete and give to Father.

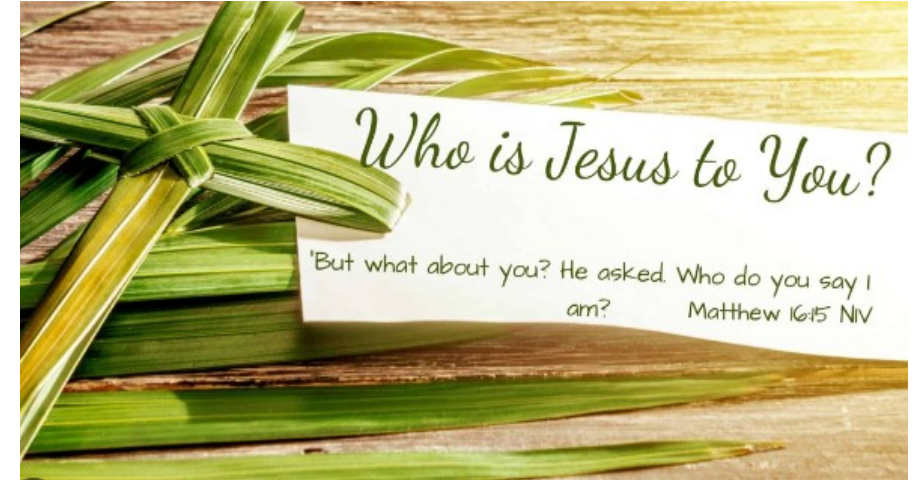

TODAY'S READINGS

FIRST READING: God places the key of David's house on the shoulders of Eliakim. *(Isaiah 22:19-23)*

PSALM: "Lord, your love is eternal; do not forsake the work of your hands." *(Psalm 138)*

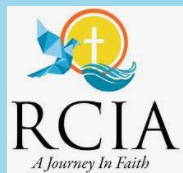
SECOND READING: To God be glory forever. *(Romans 11:33-36)*

During your journey of faith, you are gradually being formed into the image of Christ. Today, just as every believer is invited to do, you must ask yourself just who Jesus is and what meaning He has in your life. Saint Peter's answer: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus redeemed us when He died on the cross, He was raised to eternal life with the Father, and He is still with us today. As we receive Him in the Eucharist, let the "Amen" we say be our personal affirmation of Peter's answer.

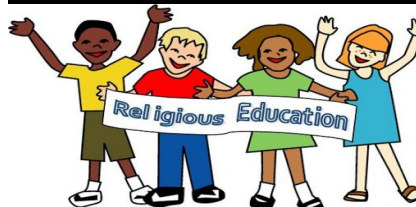
