
SACRAMENTS

29th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME **October 22, 2023**

TODAY'S READINGS

FIRST READING: We are to worship God alone, the God who calls us by name. *(Isaiah 45:1, 4-6)*

PSALM: "Give the Lord glory and honor." *(Psalm 96)*

SECOND READING: We have received the gospel not only in word, but in the power of the Holy Spirit. *(1 Thessalonians 1:1-5b)*

GOSPEL: "Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." *(Matthew 22:15-21)*

The words from today's Gospel, "repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God," are a reminder of our struggle to integrate our lives as faithful citizens with our lives as faithful Catholics. We are obligated to do both: To bring our faith and our values to all our responsibilities, including our civic ones. Whether we are conscious of it or not, all we have been given - including our very life - comes ultimately from God. May His word remind us that we too belong to God.
