

THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING November 26, 2023

TODAY'S READINGS

FIRST READING: The shepherd-king seeks the lost and heals the injured.
(Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17)

PSALM: "The Lord is my shepherd; there I nothing I shall want."
(Psalm 23)

SECOND READING: Christ our king has conquered death.
(1 Corinthians 15:20-26, 28)

GOSPEL: The Lord will come in glory to separate one from another.
(Matthew 25:31-46)

Today we are given the chance of a lifetime: A preview of what we will face at the end of time, straight from the lips of the One who will come in glory on that day. Baptism: Contact Father several weeks in advance.


Marriage: Contact Father 6 months prior to wedding. Do not schedule a date before talking with Father.
