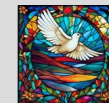

2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

January 14, 2024

TODAY'S READINGS

FIRST READING: Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening.

(1 Samuel 3:3b-10, 19)

PSALM: "Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will."

(Psalm 40)

SECOND READING: Your bodies are members of Christ.

(1 Corinthians 6:13c-15a, 17-20)

GOSPEL: They saw where he was staying and they stayed with him.

(John 1:35-42)

God calls to us in unexpected ways. For young Samuel, it was his whispered name heard in the middle of the night. Jesus called Saul when he was on his way to persecute Christians in Damascus. Today we hear him, as Paul, speak of our bodies as being temples of the Holy Spirit. We also hear of the first disciples and how their first encounter changes the course of their lives; for, as Andrew insists to his brother Simon, "We have found the Messiah." May our encounters with the Lord, here and elsewhere, influence the way we live our lives as well. - Pastoral Patterns

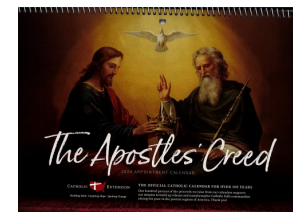
