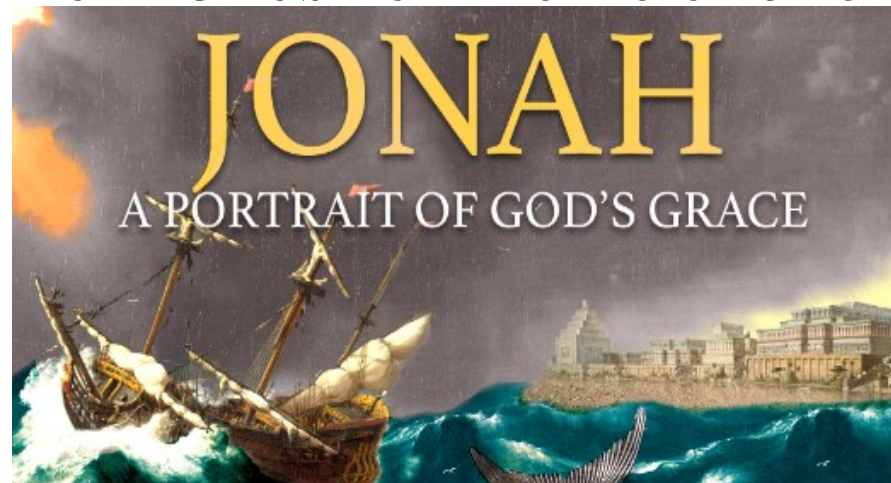

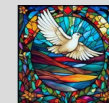

THE HOLY POST

3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

January 21, 2024

TODAY'S READINGS

FIRST READING: The Ninevites turned from their evil way.
(Jonah 3:1-5,10)

PSALM: "Teach me your ways, O Lord.." (Psalm 25)

SECOND READING: The world in its present form is passing away.
(1 Corinthians 7:29-31)

GOSPEL: Repent and believe in the Gospel. (Mark 1:14-20)

The scriptures for these first weeks in Ordinary Time speak to our hearts in a powerful way. In today's Gospel, Jesus passes by the Sea of Galilee and calls the first four disciples, two pairs of brothers: Simon and Andrew, James and John. Follow me, he tells these four fishermen, and I will make you fishers of more disciples. Jesus calls each of us to discipleship. On this Sunday of the Word of God, may the stories of Jonah, of Paul, and of the first four disciples inspire us to drop our nets and follow more closely our Lord as his disciples. - Pastoral Patterns
