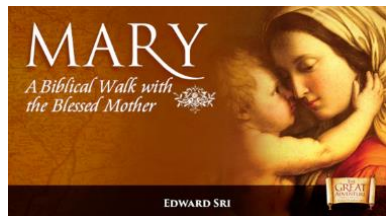

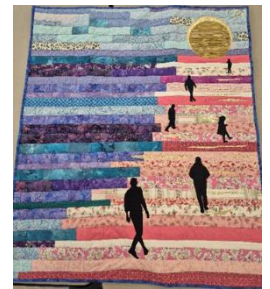
Everyone who has made a Spiritual Adoption should take a swatch / patch of fabric from the basket for every prayer, every sacrifice, every offering that you made for your

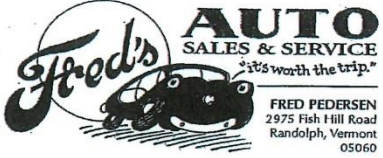
