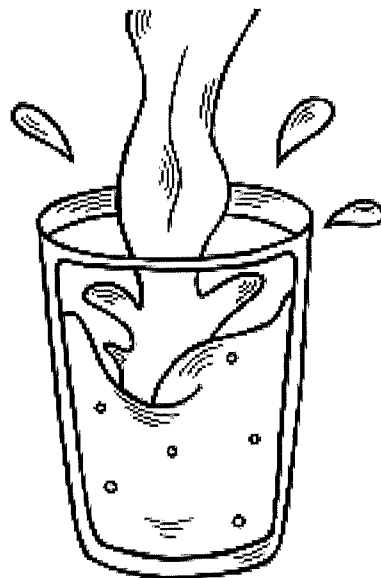

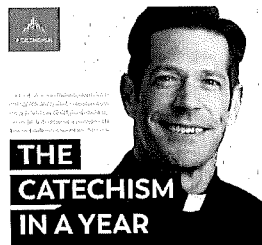

(1994 English publication) draws on the Bible, the

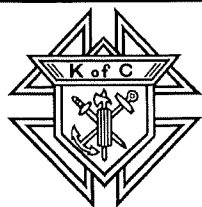
Mass, the Sacraments, Church tradition and teaching, and the lives of saints.

54-Day Rosary Novena

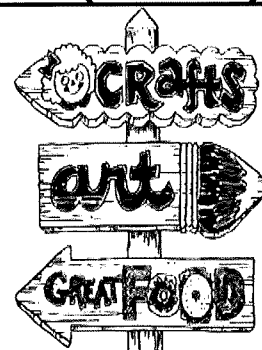

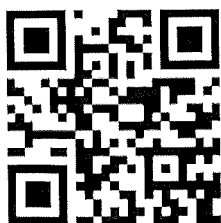
WUKR Update

Our Lady Undoer of Knots Radio has been on the air and Internet 24/7 for about 9 months. We hope that you have been able to tune in to the station. Programming has largely been EWTN, and we broadcast

Rosemary Brown's recording of the Seven Sorrows of Mary on Fridays in Lent. EWTN programs include the Holy Rosary at 5:30am and 9:30pm; daily hMass at 8am; EWTN Nightly News at 9pm; and Bible in a Year / Catechism in a Year at 10pm. We welcome ideas for locally-created programming. If you are in the Northfield - Montpelier area, you can listen on 104.1 FM on the radio; or stream from wukr1041.org from anywhere.

We have been blessed in having the use of money designated for radio station when Fr. Gratton established the project and generous donations that were received through a second collection specifically for the radio station about a year ago. We now have 501(c)(3) status for the nonprofit and gifts to the station are tax deductible.

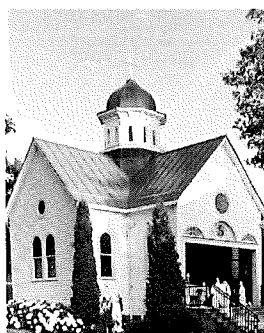

The annual Diocesan Family Day Mass will be celebrated July 19 at 12:15 p.m. at Saint Anne's Shrine in Isle La Motte with Bishop John McDermott as the celebrant. Saint Anne's Shrine is a peaceful, spiritual, and historic site that has been developed and maintained for the past 100 years by the Society of Saint Edmund in the Champlain Islands. Each season, thousands of religious pilgrims, vacationers and tourists visit the popular waterfront site in Isle La Motte for devotion and recreation. The mission of the shrine is to serve as a welcoming place of peace and hope, ministering to all God's people through prayer, devotion, hospitality, and spiritual renewal. Situated on 32 park-like acres, the shrine offers an open-air chapel, rustic grottos, a history room, a gift shop, an all-purpose facility, and picnic areas. The shrine will be providing a free-will-donation barbecue after the Family Day Mass as in the past. Visitors are welcome to bring their own picnic as well as lawn chairs and lawn games.

Want to turn Diocesan Family Day into a weekend pilgrimage? Skip the one-day round trip drive and stay a night or two in the Shrine's spacious, air-conditioned cabins. 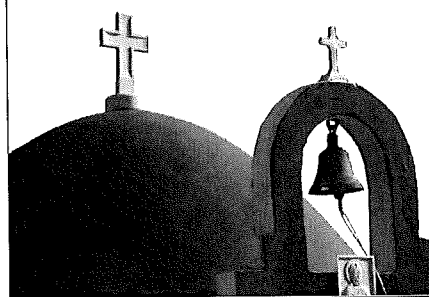
