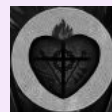

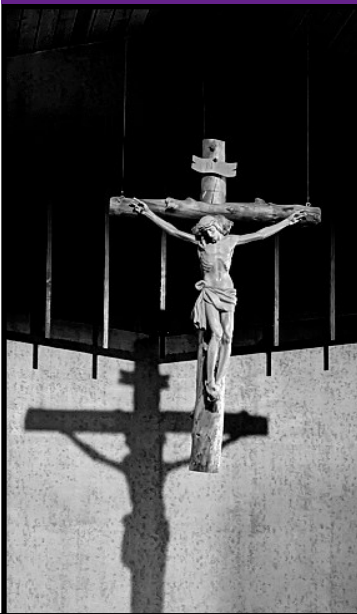
Marriage Preparation

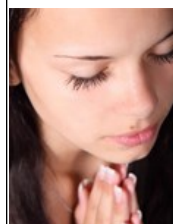
ALTAR SERVER MINISTRY

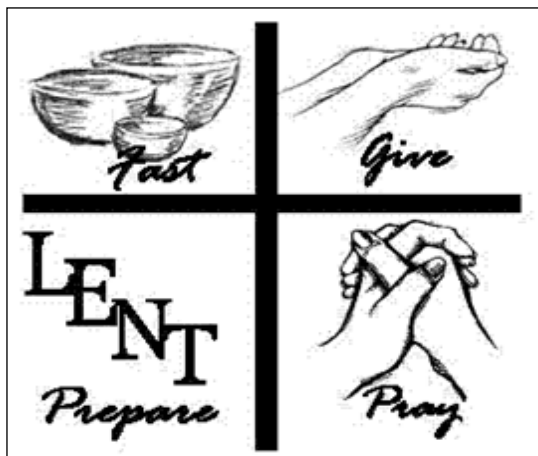

WEEK FIVE (March 30-April 6)

- Pray before every meal, "Bless us oh Lord, and these Your gifts, which we are about to receive from your bounty through Christ our Lord, Amen"
- Pray after every meal "We give you thanks, for all the good that comes from this meal, oh Lord, who feeds us, Amen"
- Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet every day
- Pray the Rosary everyday
- Perform an act of service every day this week
- Perform an act of dietary abstinence two days this week on top of Friday, for example don't eat meat, don't eat sugar, don't eat between meals, etcetera
- Abstain from non-essential technology usage three days this week such as watching TV, playing video games, scrolling through social media, browsing the internet, etcetera
