Message from the Pastor

My Dear Friends in Christ,

I am writing to give you an update on the status of repairs and improvements to the parish buildings.

Certain companies have been engaged to handle the post-hurricane recovery by the Diocese of Lake Charles. Parishes are required to route hurricane-related repairs through these companies. The main information of which you should be aware is that we are operating, not on our own timeline, but on that of the company charged with managing the restoration. The good news is that we have been told that the replacement of the ceiling in the hallway, St. Raphael Room (St. Catherine of Alexandria Library), and St. Michael Room will come soon.

We have just purchased a new 30-ton air-conditioning unit for the parish hall. There are two of these in the hall. The former unit was not repairable and we were due for a replacement before Hurricane Laura, but we were unable to complete that purchase and installation after the hurricane, due to the overall damages. The new unit is expected to arrive within the next two weeks.

In the aftermath of the hurricane, we rented a commercial generator to run the parish facilities in their entirety. We have been able to purchase that machine at a very favorable price and we will have it permanently installed. As you recall, we had our parish up and running the week after the hurricane. That would not have been possible without this generator. Had we had it at the time of the hurricane, potentially we might have been able to save a great deal of money on mitigation, since a good bit of the mitigation costs were for drying out the buildings, something that might have been accomplished by the air conditioners, if we had generator power.

We are in the process of getting quotes for renovating the parish restroom facilities. This will be a complete makeover with all new fixtures.

We have been working on beautifying the courtyard. With a couple of donations for that, we are going to make some wonderful improvements.

May God bless you. Thank you for your continued support of our parish.

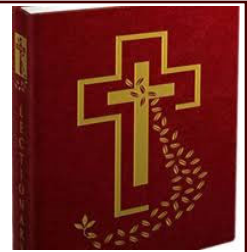
