Mary! Blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus!

During my four years as a student in Rome, there were many memorable events that took place. Mainly the two most undeniable, unforgettable events that took my breath away, and which I still cherish were my meeting with the Holy father Pope John Paul II, in Jubilee year 2000, he has been my role model since I joined the seminary; and the second one, visiting the private chapel of the Holy Father in Vatican. Visiting the private chapel is a rare opportunity for any priest, but I was destined to have this blessed occasion.

The private chapel is where the Holy Father spends time in prayer and meditation. It is filled with splendid mosaic color and heavenly beauty; and on both side is a mosaic painting with different colorful stones collected from all over the world. The Mosaic displays the stories of the Old Testament on one side of the wall and stories of the New Testament on the other side of wall; both stories end at the center of the altar. The centerpiece of the mosaic is Mother Mary sitting and on her lap is Baby Jesus. The most appealing and breath-taking piece of art I have ever seen in my life! The center of attraction is Mother Mary and baby Jesus. Mary is the THEOTOKUS. The God bearer, her womb is the tabernacle of Jesus. Most sanctified womb where she held Jesus for nine months. Yes! Blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus!

This fourth Sunday of Advent brings forth Mother Mary's role, the redemptive plan of God. Mary understood so well that God has the initiative and that He is gracious. She was to win God's favor; she was to conceive and bear a son who would be the ruler of the house of Jacob. Despite her puzzlement, Mary said, **"I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be done to me according to your will."** (Lk.1:38) It was in fulfilling God's plan for her that she experienced grace and joy. She became full of grace and the cause of our joy. It is not so much that Mary was highly favored because she had been filled with many gifts and graces, but because she was radically transformed by God when He graced her with such a surpassing love. This transformation was the very reason for Mary to rejoice.

This very same joy is what God has planned for each of us. God has chosen us, as He chose Mary, **"before the foundation of the world that we should be Holy and blameless before him"** (Eph. 1:4) to the praise of his glorious grace whereby he has transformed us, marking us with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit. The same Spirit who covered Mary with its shadow and made her womb the sanctuary of God's dwelling; That same Spirit is moving in the world today, just as powerfully, filling the hearts of all those who say "yes" to God.

This joyful Christmas message is **"nothing is impossible for God."** (Lk. 1:37) By the power of the Holy Spirit and Grace of God, Mary is the bearer of the Good News in her soul and in her body, bringing Jesus to us. May this Christmas bring us the same joy as we celebrate this year 2020! Like Mother Mary, if we believe and obey His word, we can also make Christ present within us and through us, His light can illumine the world. I wish you all a joyous Christmas and a prosperous New Year 2021!




