

Fellowship in Christ

Every year we have new converts who are prepared to receive confession, baptism, confirmation, and communion on Easter Vigil night. They lead a new life in Christ manifesting itself in the lives of the disciples. Through learning the Christian proclamation means witnessing their faith, participating in every Sunday Mass, caring for each other, and praying. On the other hand, the community of believers must show their faith by supporting them and praying for them. We are not reborn in baptism for self-sufficient aloneness. A wall will not be strong with loose bricks; the bricks must be cemented together. The best example is the first Christian community, after Jesus' resurrection formed them into a well-knit family. "The brethren devoted themselves to the apostle's instructions and the communal life, to the breaking of bread and the prayers, sharing all things in common." (Acts. 2:42)

It is not only to support or be part of the community but also to grow with every community member, to derive support from one another and grow in our faith. We are not perfect on our own, but by sharing our joy and faith with help from each other forms our perfection. Sometimes we come to the Sunday Eucharistic celebration as if we are perfect, and we don't need the community. We don't even congratulate the newly admitted members with whom we are supposed to share their joy and faith. We are not so eager to share our fellowship with one another. To belong is to share, not only our monetary support but also time, energy, talents, and service.

Fellowship means to belong, to serve God with our little, is the way to make it more. Fellowship means to come together to pray, to break the Word of God and to break the living bread. A community of such believers is assured of the power of the Holy Spirit working in them. Through worship, fellowship, and service; a Christian community is provided with staying powers. The fearful disciples had hidden from the world. Jesus proclaimed peace and sent them out to the world. Their zeal and fellowship for one another created a strong bond and gave them the power to evangelize.

Comunidad en Cristo

Cada año tenemos nuevos conversos que se preparan para recibir la confesión, el bautismo, la confirmación y la comunión en la noche de la Vigilia Pascual. No somos perfectos por nosotros mismos, pero compartiendo nuestra alegría y nuestra fe con la ayuda de los demás formamos nuestra perfección. A veces llegamos a la celebración eucarística dominical como si fuéramos perfectos y no necesitáramos a la comunidad. Ni siquiera felicitamos a los miembros recién admitidos con los que se supone que compartimos su alegría y su fe. No estamos tan dispuestos a compartir nuestra comunión con los demás. Pertenecer es compartir, no sólo nuestro apoyo monetario, sino también tiempo, energía, talentos y servicio.

Compañerismo significa pertenecer, servir a Dios con nuestro poco, es la manera de hacerlo más. Compañerismo significa reunirse para orar, partir la Palabra de Dios y partir el pan vivo. Una comunidad de creyentes así tiene la seguridad del poder del Espíritu Santo obrando en ellos. A través de la adoración, el culto, la comunión y el servicio, una comunidad cristiana recibe el poder del Espíritu Santo. Los temerosos discípulos se habían escondido del mundo. Jesús proclamó la paz y los envió al mundo. Su celo y compañerismo mutuo crearon un fuerte vínculo y les dieron el poder de evangelizar.

Second Sunday of Easter (or of Divine Mercy)

EXEMPLAR OF THE FAITH

Poor Thomas. Singled out from among the disciples because he refused to believe what they were telling him—that they had seen, in the flesh, their friend and their Lord, Jesus Christ. Can any of us really blame him? All of the disciples were terrified, crestfallen, hiding. But what of Thomas? Just where was he when Jesus appeared the first time to the group huddled in fear? He had gone "out"out of the community where his faith had life. Maybe this was actually a blessing for Thomas and not the curse associated with the "doubting Thomas" moniker bestowed on him by tradition. Oh, the divine mercy of the Lord! Could Thomas be the forerunner of all of us who come in fragile hope and uncertainty to the Christian community, so beautifully described in the reading from the Acts of the Apostles? Could Thomas be an ultimate exemplar of the faith described in the First Letter of Peter?

OUR FASCINATING FAITH Divine Mercy

Saint John Paul II named the Second Sunday of Easter "Sunday of Divine Mercy" in response to Saint Faustina Kowalska's Divine Mercy devotion, which offered spiritual comfort to hearts worldwide. But Pope Francis challenges us to make the comfort that we receive a gift we gladly share, saying that because mercy was first shown to us we are therefore called to show mercy ourselves. The clearest expression of merciful love, says Francis, is pardoning others. He acknowledges how difficult it can be to forgive sometimes, but if we are to achieve peace in our hearts, pardon is the tool that has been put into our very fallible hands. The necessary condition for living joyfully? We must let go of anger, hatred, revenge, and violence. A tall order in a world seemingly bent on the destruction of every peaceful impulse. May Divine Mercy Sunday remind us that Jesus made mercy our life's ideal and a criterion for our faith's credibility: "Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy" (Matthew 5:7).
