The Mountain of Eternal Banquet

The parable of the wedding feast is really a story of the kingdom of God. God's invitation was first made to the chosen people. This was a free act of kindness, Pharisees and other leaders of Jesus' time rejected this call. God's invitation was then made to everybody without discrimination. It includes all out-casts of society, the good and the bad. Being invited, however, does not qualify a person from not observing the proper conduct of an invited person to a grand wedding banquet. We are expected to dress accordingly and behave decently. For example, many of our parishioners are forgetting this very core concept of dress code and decency and taking time to enter the mountain of the eternal banquet. Wholeheartedly participating means dressed up for the occasion. Regularly coming late to the Eucharist, more than five minutes late or not entering the Church before the start of the Holy Mass, shows our luke-warmness to the Loving Father. He deserves our full love, honor, praise, and glory. He invites us to listen to his words and to take part in the eternal banquet prepared for us, THE EUCHARISTIC BANQUET. There is no automatic entry into heaven; we need to wear the garment of salvation, a garment of a converted life, full of righteousness. All sinners are invited but they are expected to repent, have a change of heart, and dress up according to the dignity of our call. If our Loving God has invited us to participate in his Son's sacrificial banquet, then we all need to act, behave, and dress accordingly.

The guest in the parable at the wedding (Mt. 22:1-14) represents those who have failed to understand the fundamental teaching. The invitee has accepted the King's generous invitation, but by failing to dress appropriately, he has demonstrated an overly casual attitude, treating the event as if it is simply a matter of "*come as you are*" an insult to the generosity of the King. We fail to learn or know how serious it is to be part of the divinity when we are in Church during the Eucharistic celebration. In Church matters, or any sacramental matters we should take great pride; for the kingdom of God, in the parable reminds us, that is not something we should take for granted.

Spiritually speaking, the king sent his servants out to invite us to the wedding banquet. They invited whomever they found after the special guests rejected his invitation. As part from our physical dress code, we also need to dress for the banquet by asking for and responding to God's gratuitous and loving presence. Our wedding garments entail clothing ourselves with gratitude, humility, and love, like Saint Paul writes to the Philippians, "***I can do all things in him who strengthens me.***" (Phil. 4:14) Let us glorify him with our desire and willingness to fulfill the requirement of entering the mountain of the eternal banquet. Pope Francis writes, "*The way of the Church is not to condemn anyone forever, it is to pour out the balm of God's mercy on all those who ask for it with a sincere heart.... For true charity is always unmerited, unconditional, and gratuitous.*" (Amoris Laetitia)

As a community, we need to put on the dress of love, mercy, and generosity as we come to the table of the Lord. As brothers and sisters of Christ, our community needs the healing balm to communicate, greet, talk to each other, listen, share and to feel the fellowship of heaven on earth.

La Montaña del Banquete Eterno

La parábola del banquete de bodas es en realidad una historia del reino de Dios. La invitación de Dios se hizo primero al pueblo elegido. Este fue un acto gratuito de bondad, los fariseos y otros líderes de la época de Jesús rechazaron este llamado. Entonces la invitación de Dios se hizo a todos sin discriminación. Él Incluye a todos los marginados de la sociedad, los buenos y los malos. Sin embargo, ser invitado no exime a una persona de no observar la conducta apropiada de una persona invitada a un gran banquete de bodas. Se espera que nos vistamos correctamente y nos comportemos decentemente. Por ejemplo, muchos de nuestros feligreses están olvidando este concepto fundamental de código de vestimenta y decencia y se toman el tiempo para entrar a la montaña del banquete eterno. Participar de todo corazón significa vestirse para la ocasión. Llegar tarde regularmente a la Eucaristía, más de cinco minutos tarde o no entrar a la Iglesia antes del comienzo de la Santa Misa, muestra nuestra tibieza hacia un Padre Amoroso. Él merece todo nuestro amor, honor, alabanza y gloria. Nos invita a escuchar sus palabras y a participar en el banquete eterno preparado para nosotros, EL BANQUETE EUCARÍSTICO. No existe una entrada automática al cielo; necesitamos usar el manto de la salvación, el manto de una vida convertida, llena de justicia. Todo Los pecadores están invitados, pero se espera que se arrepientan, cambien de opinión y se vistan de acuerdo con la dignidad de nuestro llamado. Si nuestro Dios amoroso nos ha invitado a participar en el sacrificio de su Hijo banquete, entonces todos debemos actuar, comportarnos y vestirnos en consecuencia.

El invitado en la parábola a la boda (Mt. 22:1-14) representa a aquellos que no han cumplido comprender la enseñanza fundamental. El invitado ha aceptado la generosa invitación del Rey. invitación, pero al no vestirse apropiadamente, ha demostrado una actitud demasiado informal. actitud, tratando el evento como si fuera simplemente una cuestión de "ven como eres", un insulto a la generosidad del Rey. No aprendemos ni sabemos cuán serio es ser parte de la divinidad cuando estamos en la Iglesia durante la celebración eucarística. En asuntos de la Iglesia, o cualquier En los asuntos sacramentales debemos sentirnos muy orgullosos; para el reino de Dios, en la parábola nos recuerda que esto no es algo que debamos dar por concedido.

En términos espirituales, el rey envió a sus siervos a invitarnos al banquete de bodas. Invitaron a quien encontraron después de que los invitados especiales rechazaron su invitación. Como parte de nuestro código de vestimenta física, también debemos vestirnos para el banquete pidiendo y respondiendo a la presencia gratuita y amorosa de Dios. Nuestros vestidos de boda implican vestirnos de gratitud, humildad y amor, como escribe San Pablo a los Filipenses: "**Todo lo puedo en aquel que me fortalece**". (Fil. 4:14) Glorifiquémosle con nuestro deseo y voluntad de cumplir el requisito de entrando en la montaña del banquete eterno. El Papa Francisco escribe: "*El camino de la Iglesia no es condurar a nadie para siempre, es derramar el bálsamo de la misericordia de Dios sobre todos aquellos que lo piden con un corazón sincero.... Porque la verdadera caridad es siempre inmerecida, incondicional y gratuita*". (Amoris Laetitia)

Como comunidad, debemos vestirnos de amor, misericordia y generosidad al acercarnos a la mesa del Señor. Como hermanos y hermanas de Cristo, nuestra comunidad necesita el bálsamo sanador para comunicarnos, saludarnos, conversar, escuchar, compartir y sentir la comunión del cielo en la tierra.

Protecting vulnerable adults

While a primary focus of those in ministry is on protecting children from harm, protecting vulnerable adults is just as important. This includes adults living with mental, emotional, or physical disabilities, adults who have court-appointed guardians, elderly adults in vulnerable positions, and anyone else who may be unable to consent to or understand what is happening to them. Every year, nearly 500,000 reports of abuse against vulnerable adults are made to the Adult Protection Service, and even more go undetected. The same steps and processes outlined for protecting children can help vulnerable adults as well — know the warning signs, screen all employees and caregivers, and monitor environments for safe practices. Protegiendo a los adultos vulnerables

Si bien el enfoque principal de quienes están en el ministerio de protección a los niños del peligro, la protección de los adultos vulnerables es igualmente importante. Esto incluye adultos que viven con discapacidades mentales, emocionales o físicas, adultos que tienen tutores designados por el tribunal, adultos mayores en posiciones vulnerables y cualquier otra persona que no pueda dar su consentimiento o comprender lo que les está sucediendo. Cada año, se presentan al Servicio de Protección de Adultos casi 500 mil denuncias de abuso contra adultos vulnerables, y muchas más pasan desapercibidas. Los mismos pasos y procesos descritos para proteger a los niños también pueden ayudar a los adultos vulnerables a conocer las señales de advertencia, evaluar a todos los empleados y cuidadores y monitorear los entornos para detectar prácticas seguras.
