## Our gift of talents

Last Sunday we commissioned new liturgical ministers, and our current ministers renewed their commitment to their ministry to serve the Lord and his people. They received formation and training. Proverbs 31 describes a woman with many valuable qualities. Let us ask this question to ourselves. Which qualities stand out to me the most and why? Sometimes we realize that God has given us a valuable talent or gift, but we haven't used it for the greater glory of God, community, or family. The text from Proverbs mentions "***the woman who fears the LORD.***" (Proverbs 31:30-31) She was praised because she brought good not evil. Sometimes our fear of God is for the sake of fulfilling the duties of our Sunday obligation. The true fear comes from the true love of God. Many of us don't even wait to the end of the Mass; without true love for God, we make excuses that we have to leave Church early, and that excuse seems to be more important than God and community.

The Parable of the Talents focuses on the concept of stewardship. How do you apply this idea to your own life? Are there areas where you feel you could be a better steward? Yes, the first and second servants took the risks and developed the gifts which were multiplied, and they gained the praise and reward from the master. What about us? The third servant in the parable is held back by fear. Can you relate to this? How does fear limit your actions? Fear kept him from taking the risks needed to grow what he had been given. The master chided him for being lazy. He didn't want to take any risk needed to develop the gifts that he had been given. We too have the same kind of situation; we make excuses and don't want to take risk or pain to develop our own God-given gifts.

Both passages from 1Thessalonians and Matthew stress readiness and proactive behavior. When the Thessalonians did not experience Jesus' immediate return, Saint Paul encouraged them to keep using and developing the gifts that God gave them. He asked them to live as children of the light, alert, sober, and ready for whenever Christ returns. How do you prepare for unpredictable events in your life, spiritual or otherwise? The Thessalonians talks about being "***sober and alert.***" What steps are you taking to be aware of your spiritual and ethical responsibilities? How do we use our God-given gifts during good times and bad times?

Generally, we all received various gifts accordingly; many have artistic gifts, artists, sculptors; they create and beautify our environment for our Creator's glory; musicians are called to use their gifts to glorify God by singing or playing an instrument. All of us have gifts of time and are called to use it not only for ourselves but in the service of our community. We all have gifts of money, more or less. How often do we become generous and share to the needy or to our own community to build and maintain our house of God? The Lord who is the source of all gifts will return to ask for an account. The man who goes on a journey abroad and returns after a long time, is an image of Christ who have journeyed to the Father and is expected to return again. (Mt. 25:14) We all will have to give an account to Him, according to the gifts that we have received.

## El Don de Nuestros Talentos

El domingo pasado comisionamos nuevos ministros litúrgicos y nuestros ministros actuales renovaron su compromiso con su ministerio de servir al Señor y su pueblo. Recibieron formación y entrenamiento. Proverbios 31 describe a una mujer con muchas cualidades valiosas. Hagámonos esta pregunta a nosotros mismos. ¿Qué cualidades me destacan más y por qué? A veces nos damos cuenta de que Dios nos ha dado un talento o don valioso, pero no lo hemos usado para la mayor gloria de Dios, la comunidad o la familia. El texto de Proverbios menciona "***la mujer que teme al Señor.***" (Proverbios 31:30-31) Ella fue alabada porque trajo el bien y no el mal. A veces nuestro temor de Dios es para cumplir con los deberes de nuestra obligación dominical. El verdadero temor proviene del verdadero amor de Dios. Muchos de nosotros ni siquiera esperamos hasta el final de la Misa; Sin verdadero amor por Dios, ponemos excusas diciendo que tenemos que dejar la Iglesia temprano, y esa excusa parece ser más importante que Dios y la comunidad.

La parábola de los talentos se centra en el concepto de mayordomía. ¿Cómo aplicas esta idea a tu propia vida? ¿Hay áreas en las que cree que podría ser un mejor administrador? Sí, el primer y segundo siervo asumieron riesgos y desarrollaron los dones que se multiplicaron, y obtuvieron la alabanza y la recompensa del amo. ¿Qué pasa con nosotros? El tercer siervo de la parábola está retenido por el miedo. ¿Puedes identificarte con esto? ¿Cómo limita el miedo tus acciones? El miedo le impidió correr los riesgos necesarios para hacer crecer lo que le habían dado. El maestro lo reprendió por ser perezoso. No quería correr ningún riesgo necesario para desarrollar los dones que le habían dado. Nosotros también tenemos el mismo tipo de situación; ponemos excusas y no queremos correr riesgos ni sufrir dolor para desarrollar los dones que Dios nos ha dado.

Ambos pasajes de 1 Tesalonicenses y Mateo enfatizan la preparación y el comportamiento proactivo. Cuando los tesalonicenses no experimentaron el regreso inmediato de Jesús, San Pablo los animó a seguir usando y desarrollando los dones que Dios les dio. Les pidió que vivieran como hijos de la luz, alertas, sobrios y preparados para cuando Cristo regrese. ¿Cómo te preparas para eventos impredecibles en tu vida, espirituales o de otro tipo? Los Tesalonicenses hablan de *estar "sobrios y alertas"*. ¿Qué pasos estás tomando para ser consciente de tus responsabilidades espirituales y éticas? ¿Cómo utilizamos los dones que Dios nos ha dado durante los buenos y los malos tiempos?

Generalmente, todos recibimos diversos obsequios en consecuencia; muchos tienen dotes artísticas, artistas, escultores; crean y embellecen nuestro entorno para la gloria de nuestro Creador; Los músicos están llamados a usar sus dones para glorificar a Dios cantando o tocando un instrumento. Todos tenemos el don del tiempo y estamos llamados a usarlo no sólo para nosotros mismos sino también para el servicio de nuestra comunidad. Todos tenemos regalos de dinero, más o menos. ¿Con qué frecuencia nos volvemos generosos y compartimos con los necesitados o con nuestra propia comunidad para construir y mantener nuestra casa de Dios? El Señor que es la fuente de todos los dones volverá a pedir cuentas. El hombre que sale de viaje al extranjero y regresa después de mucho tiempo, es una imagen de Cristo que ha viajado hacia el Padre y se espera que regrese nuevamente. (Mt. 25:14) Todos tendremos que dar cuenta a Él, según los dones que hayamos recibido.

- + The Flame blinds Satan, causing him to lose his power over persons and situations. This allows people to respond to God's graces and be sanctified.
- + Mary, Mother to All People, wants to pour out the Flame into every heart. As a good mother would, Mary suffers until she can find souls who want to receive this Flame.
- + The effects of the Flame of Love graces is to sanctify and save souls, release souls from purgatory, and to usher in the Final Triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary and the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
