## The Sacrament of healing

I always do my best to attend to the sick calls. I reach out promptly to the suffering who call me to administer to them the Sacrament of healing or Sacrament of anointing. The Sacrament of healing is one of the most important Sacraments of our Catholic Church. Jesus never said no or delayed healing the person suffering from leprosy, or any other sickness. It was not only relieving the man of his physical illness but also freeing him from his bondage of sin. He was removing from him the social stigma that was attached to leprosy. The man had then only to go to a priest for a clean sheet, a confirmation that he was well again and entitled to mix around in society just like any other normal person.

Jesus' mission was not just to heal the person but their soul as well. It means He wants to save us. That is why, when sending out his apostles he said, "***Preach the good news of salvation and heal the sick.***" (Luke 9:2) When every ordained priest is called to anoint the sick with the Sacrament of Holy oil of the sick; the sick person is not only receiving the healing but also the forgiveness of sins. When he is reconciled with God, the total healing will be received, and we praise God for the Sacrament of healing. "***Whatever we do, we will do for the glory of God.***" (1 Cor. 10:31) A cheerful spirit helps a great deal to recover from illness. The human health comes to a great extent as an indirect but precious consequence of reconciliation, namely salvation.

Most of the sick people, whether they are at home, in the hospital or homecare, request confession for their sins then the anointing and Holy Communion. They want to reconcile with God and long for the salvation for their souls through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Jesus, the all-sufficient physician of humanity, earns for his free gift of salvation which is health in the ultimate sense that is to redeem us from our bondage of sins. I have witnessed many Catholics who died peacefully after receiving the Sacrament of healing of health and soul. Jesus wants to heal us, and he wants to save us in order to heal us. Today we are grateful to all the ordained priests who visit the sick and show great pastoral care for the sick and the dying. They have taken this ministry of healing so seriously; they are ever ready to visit and anoint the sick with holy oil and redeemed them from sin and show them the path to heaven.

When we need confession, communion and anointing on our last breath, the angels of heaven won't come down from heaven to heal us and forgive our sins or give us Holy Communion, it is the ordained priest who will be on our side and administer the Sacraments. We should also be grateful to all the chaplains, deacons, and Extraordinary ministers who reach out to the sick and dying to give communion and comfort them when they need the Church community. "***Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.***" (James 5:14-16)

## El sacramento de la sanación

Siempre hago lo mejor que puedo para atender las llamadas de enfermos. Acudo prontamente a los que sufren que me llaman para administrarles el Sacramento de la curación o Sacramento de la unción. El Sacramento de la curación es uno de los sacramentos más importantes de nuestra Iglesia Católica. Jesús nunca dijo que no ni retrasó la curación de la persona que padecía lepra o cualquier otra enfermedad. No sólo era aliviar al hombre de su enfermedad física sino también liberarlo de la esclavitud del pecado. Estaba quitándole el estigma social que acompañaba a la lepra. Entonces el hombre sólo tuvo que acudir a un sacerdote para que le dejaran limpio, una confirmación de que estaba bien de nuevo y tenía derecho a mezclarse en la sociedad como cualquier otra persona normal.

La misión de Jesús no era sólo sanar a la persona sino también su alma. Significa que quiere salvarnos. Por eso, al enviar a sus apóstoles, dijo: "***Predicad la buena nueva de salvación y sanad a los enfermos.***" (Lucas 9:2) Cuando todo sacerdote ordenado es llamado a ungir a los enfermos con el Sacramento del Santo Óleo de los enfermos; el enfermo no sólo está recibiendo la curación sino también el perdón de los pecados. Cuando se reconcilia con Dios, recibirá la curación total y alabamos a Dios por el Sacramento de la curación. "***Todo lo que hagamos, lo haremos para la gloria de Dios.***" (1 Cor. 10:31) Un espíritu alegre ayuda mucho a recuperarse de la enfermedad. La salud humana es en gran medida una consecuencia indirecta pero preciosa de la reconciliación, es decir, la salvación.

La mayoría de los enfermos, ya sea en casa, en el hospital o en la asistencia domiciliaria, piden la confesión de sus pecados y luego la unción y la Sagrada Comunión. Quieren reconciliarse con Dios y anhelan la salvación de sus almas a través del Sacramento de la Reconciliación. Jesús, el médico todo suficiente de la humanidad, gana por su regalo gratuito de la salvación, que es salud en el sentido último de redimirnos de nuestra esclavitud del pecado. He sido testigo de muchos católicos que murieron pacíficamente después de recibir el Sacramento de curación de la salud y del alma. Jesús quiere sanarnos y quiere salvarnos para sanarnos. Hoy estamos agradecidos a todos los sacerdotes ordenados que visitan a los enfermos y muestran un gran cuidado pastoral por los enfermos y los moribundos. Han tomado muy en serio este ministerio de sanación; siempre están listos para visitar y ungir a los enfermos con el óleo santo y redimirlos del pecado y mostrarles el camino al cielo.

Cuando necesitemos confesión, comunión y unción en nuestro último aliento, los ángeles del cielo no bajarán del cielo para sanarnos y perdonar nuestros pecados o darnos la Sagrada Comunión, es el sacerdote ordenado quien estará a nuestro lado y administrará los Sacramentos. También debemos estar agradecidos a todos los capellanes, diáconos y ministerio Extraordinario que se acercan a los enfermos y moribundos para darles la comunión y consolarlos cuando necesitan la comunidad de la Iglesia. "***¿Hay alguno entre ustedes que esté enfermo? Llame a los ancianos de la iglesia, y oren por él, ungíendolo con aceite en el nombre del Señor. Y la oración de fe salvará al enfermo, y el Señor lo resucitará. Y si ha cometido pecados, le serán perdonados.***" (Santiago 5:14-16)


