

Concern

We are so indulged in the social media that even in the church we are distracted. We are tempted to spend time on our cell phone rather than spend some in quiet and silent prayer with the Lord. In our fast-paced and technologically driven world, it is easy to become distracted, preoccupied, or resistant to God's Word. We find we are easily bored by the words of God proclaimed and shared by the lectors and the main celebrant. Most the time we find ourselves captivated by the constant influx of information, consumed by the noise of the world, or numbed by indifference. Our conversations and human communication have become lesser and fewer as we have witnessed the image of distracted smartphone users in the pews.

Let it be a wake-up call to the urgent need for receptivity and attentiveness to the Word of God. Let us learn from the story of Martha and Mary. Martha was too much occupied by the worldly things, but Mary found the way to be with the Lord. Mary was not just leaning onto the feet of Jesus, but she was listening, and feeling the presence of the Lord, meditating on His words. Let us strive to be like Mary, good soil that receives, and nurtures; good eyes to see around us and allow God's word to take root within us. It is in this receptivity that we find the key to personal transformation and the abundant harvest of joy, peace, and purpose.

Today we will leave the Holy Mass, and we will see many people, let's not just see people but see with compassion and mercy. Some will irritate us. Some will insult us. Some will be weary of you. Each one of them is Jesus. He walks the earth disguised as troublesome people, to teach us how to love. Love isn't a feeling; it is a decision, and only this decision to love brings us true joy. We are invited to make the effort to love the people we don't want to love. To focus on the Lord, and to walk with Him.

Martha also loved Jesus from her heart, but she was distracted with all the serving and was “ **worrying and fretting about many things.** ” (Luke 10:41) Jesus was not prompting prayer against action, nor exalting the contemplative life over and against the active life. We are reminded again that we should take time and listen to our Lord. Martha was not just busy, but too busy to care for anything spiritual.

We should not allow our minds to get so clouded by turmoil from everyday living that we lose sight of our priorities in life; when this happens, we must pause at the feet of the Lord and let the murky waters of the mind become clear again. Like Mary, let us choose better part!

La Preocupación

Estamos tan entregados a las redes sociales que incluso en la iglesia nos distraemos. Tenemos la tentación de pasar tiempo con el móvil en lugar de dedicar algo de tiempo a la oración tranquila y silenciosa con el Señor. En nuestro mundo tecnológico y acelerado, es fácil distraerse, preocuparse o resistirse a la Palabra de Dios. Nos aburrirnos fácilmente con las palabras de Dios proclamadas y compartidas por los lectores y el celebrante principal. La mayoría de las veces nos encontramos cautivados por la afluencia constante e información, consumidos por el ruido del mundo o adormecidos por la indiferencia. Nuestras conversaciones y la comunicación humana se han vuelto cada vez menos frecuentes, a medida que hemos sido testigos de la imagen de usuarios de teléfonos inteligentes distraídos en los bancos.

Que sea una llamada de atención sobre la urgente necesidad de receptividad y atención a la Palabra de Dios. Aprendamos de la historia de Marta y María. Marta estaba demasiado ocupada con las cosas del mundo, pero María encontró el camino para estar con el Señor. María no sólo se apoyaba en los pies de Jesús, sino que escuchaba y sentía la presencia del Señor, meditando sus palabras. Esforcémonos por ser como María, tierra buena que recibe y nutre; ojos buenos para ver a nuestro alrededor y permitir que la palabra de Dios arraigue en nosotros. Es en esta receptividad donde encontramos la clave para la transformación personal y la cosecha abundante de alegría, paz y propósito.

Hoy saldremos de la Santa Misa, y veremos a mucha gente, no veamos a la gente sin más, sino veámosla con compasión y misericordia. Algunos nos irritarán. Algunos nos insultarán. Algunos nos cansarán. Cada uno de ellos es Jesús. Él camina por la tierra disfrazado de personas molestas, para enseñarnos a amar. El amor no es un sentimiento; es una decisión, y sólo esta decisión de amar nos trae la verdadera alegría. Se nos invita a hacer el esfuerzo de amar a las personas que no queremos amar. A centrarnos en el señor, y a caminar con Él.

Marta también amaba a Jesús de corazón, pero estaba distraída con tanto servir y se “**inquietaba y se agitaba por muchas cosas**”. (Lucas 10:41) Jesús no estaba incitando a la oración contra la acción, ni exaltando la vida contemplativa por encima y en contra de la vida activa. Se nos recuerda de nuevo que debemos tomarnos tiempo y escuchar a nuestro Señor. Marta no sólo estaba ocupada, sino que estaba demasiado ocupada para ocuparse de algo espiritual.

No debemos permitir que nuestras mentes se nublen tanto por la agitación de la vida cotidiana que perdamos de vista nuestras prioridades en la vida; cuando esto sucede, debemos hacer una pausa a los pies del Señor y dejar que las aguas turbias de la mente se aclaren de nuevo. Como María, ¡elijamos la mejor parte!
