

## A Time For Prayer

Moses went up the hill and extended his arms in prayer until the victory was won (Ex. 17:12-13) When we persevere at God's door praying, He will come. It is necessary to fix a time for prayer in one's daily schedule and to persevere in it, even though God may delay His answer for various good reasons. The judge in the Gospel had probably ignored the please of the old widow many times, but she never gave up. She kept making new trips down to the judge's office day and night, till the wicked judge relented. ***"Yet because this widow keeps bothering me, I will see that she gets justice, so that she won't eventually come and attack me!"*** (Luke 18:5) If persistence prevails with a judge, who cared only for his own convenience and comforts, how much more will it prevail with a gracious God.

He may delay to respond to our prayer in order to purify our motives, so that we ask Him for what we need, rather than for what we want. He delay in order to, ***"to reprove, correct, train us in holiness, so that fully equipped and competent, for every good work."*** (2 Tim. 3:16)

Luke writes that Jesus told his disciples a parable about the need to pray continually without ceasing. Through, His parable, Jesus teaches us to be consistent and persevere in praying at all times. Of course, having been a man of prayer himself, He knew how important prayer was for his disciples. It will be the key to their success in their mission. In every success in our respective vocation and missions, we must make prayer the foundation of our Christian life. It is an indispensable tool that every Christian needs for success. The prayer in question here is one that never gives up and that one draws strength from the word of God. We must never be tired of praying because God is never tired of listening to us. He might take time to open the door like the judge in the parable. However, if we do not quit, He will surely hear and answer us.

We need to pray because God himself will come and fill our emptiness with his own fullness. Prayer is an act of faith in God and in God's love. When faith sets prayer to work, prayer sets God to work. No Christian lives without prayer; prayer is the answer to our faith and life. Our adoration Chapel is opened from 7:00 am to 9:00 pm and the Church is always open from morning 7:00 am to 6:00pm. All are welcome to pray and pray. He waits for you and me to talk to him!

## Un Momento Para la Oración

Moisés subió a la colina y extendió sus brazos en oración hasta que se obtuvo la victoria (Éxodo 17:12-13). Cuando perseveramos a la puerta de Dios orando, Él vendrá. Es necesario fijar un tiempo para la oración en la agenda diaria y perseverar en ello, aunque Dios pueda retrasar su respuesta por diversas razones válidas. Probablemente, el juez del Evangelio había ignorado muchas veces las súplicas de la anciana viuda, pero ella nunca se rindió. Siguió acudiendo a la oficina del juez día y noche, hasta que el malvado juez cedió. ***"Pero como esta viuda me molesta tanto, le haré justicia, para que no venga a fastidiarme"***. (Lucas 18:5). Si la persistencia prevaleció ante un juez que solo se preocupaba por su propia comodidad y conveniencia, cuanto más prevalecerá ante un Dios misericordioso.

Él puede demorarse en responder a nuestras oraciones con el fin de purificar nuestras motivaciones, para que le pidamos lo que necesitamos, en lugar de lo que queremos. Él se demora con el fin de ***"enseñar y para argüir, para corregir y para educar en la justicia"*** (2 Timoteo 3:16).

Lucas escribe que Jesús contó a sus discípulos una parábola sobre la necesidad de orar continuamente sin cesar. A través de su parábola, Jesús nos enseña a ser constantes y perseverantes en la oración en todo momento. Por supuesto, habiendo sido él mismo un hombre de oración, sabía lo importante que era la oración para sus discípulos. La oración será la clave del éxito de su misión. En cada éxito de nuestra respectiva vocación y misión, debemos hacer de la oración el fundamento de nuestra vida cristiana. Es una herramienta indispensable que todo cristiano necesita para tener éxito. La oración a la que nos referimos aquí es aquella que nunca se rinde y que saca fuerzas de la palabra de Dios. Nunca debemos cansarnos de orar porque Dios nunca se cansa de escucharnos. Puede que le lleve tiempo abrir la puerta, como al juez de la parábola. Sin embargo, si no nos rendimos, Él seguramente nos escuchará y nos responderá.

Necesitamos rezar porque Dios mismo vendrá y llenará nuestro vacío con su propia plenitud. La oración es un acto de fe en Dios y en el amor de Dios. Cuando la fe pone en marcha la oración, la oración pone en marcha a Dios. Ningún cristiano vive sin oración; la oración es la respuesta a nuestra fe y a nuestra vida. Nuestra capilla de adoración está abierta de 7:00am. a 9:00pm. y la iglesia está siempre abierta desde las 7:00am. hasta las 6:00pm. Todos son bienvenidos a orar y rezar. ¡Él espera que tú y yo hablemos con él!

**COMMISSIONING OF OUR LITURGICAL MINISTERS****Altar Servers, Children's Liturgy, Sacristans, Lectors, Ushers, Music Ministers, Extra-ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to Mass and the homebound**

Commissioning of our Liturgical ministers took place last Sunday for both our English and Spanish speaking ministers. Lay ministers make a commitment to serve the faithful, they step up because they see the need of the Church, or they were asked, or they were spiritually called to the role. Once that "yes" is given, the next steps are sometimes very challenging for an individual, because this YES is not just to help when one feels like it, or to show up late, and everyone else should be glad you even came, no, this is a sacrifice that wills you forward at all cost. It's a calling.

Hence when we ask our ministers, to come forward, this coming forward to be commissioned is like a 'no turning back" point. Commissioning follows the example of Acts 13, in which the church in Antioch sent out two of its members to share the gospel:

"While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, 'Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.' Then after fasting and praying they laid their hands on them and sent them off." (Acts 13:2-3) It's a public commitment to serve the Church. And it's an opportunity for the Church to recognize the individuals' roles and responsibilities to support them in their ministry.

We had 23 Altar servers – four (4) new apprentices ready and excited to begin their service to the Lord assisting the priest, serving the faithful. We are very proud of all our servants who were present. Our Lectors – called to proclaim the Sacred Scriptures to the assembly. Our music ministry – uses their gifts to help us in our worship of God at every liturgy. Sacristans- the invisible, visible servants. Our amazing Ushers – the first front of our Church, greeting and helping all in attendance.

Children's Liturgy – they help strengthen the spiritual growth of our children through the Word of God and other resources year-round. And our Extra-ordinary ministers of Holy communion to Mass and to the homebound - they are examples of Christian living in faith and conduct.

To be commissioned is to be given the blessing to serve. One is now ready to live out one's faith through obedience, dedication and contribution to one's Church mission.

Misunderstandings and misconceptions about a person’s individual disabilities can put that person at risk for abuse. By adopting practices that aim to understand a person’s unique circumstances, abilities, and challenges, we can work to protect those who are vulnerable in our communities. Some examples which can help help foster safety and community include: asking questions instead of making assumptions, focusing on a person’s abilities and using positive language. 
