Other authors may be substituted with the approval of the Public Library staff as to grade level.

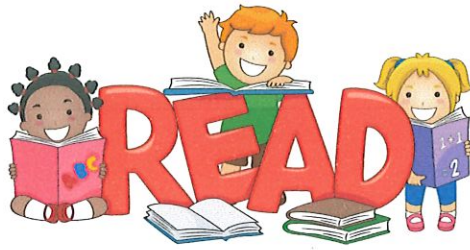

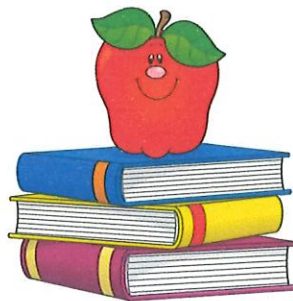
