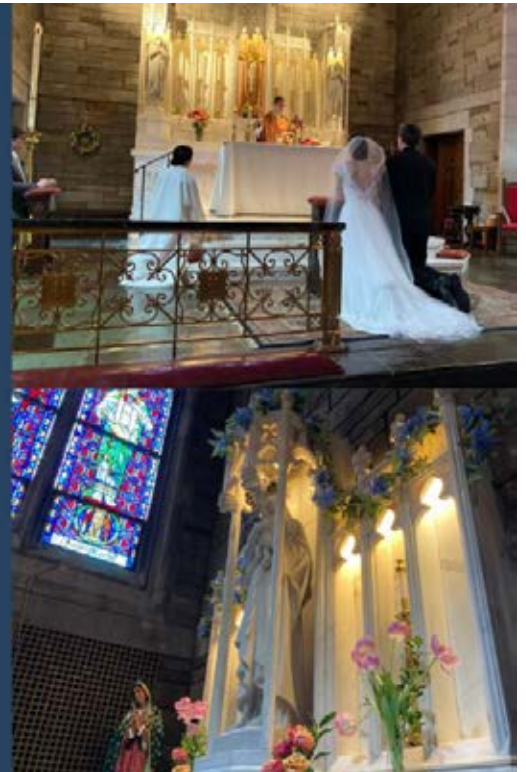

How to Support St. Agnes





AROUND THE PARISH

FROM OUTREACH SERVICES

In our Day Room, each day we serve everyone who comes to our window. For the past several weeks, this has meant serving over 150 people every day. While we knew that we were serving a large number of guests, it was only this past week when we came to realize just how many people were coming to us for assistance.

In March, we served 1,400 meals. In April, we served over 2,900 meals. That's nearly double. These meals are prepared by volunteers or donated by local restaurants.

We continue to be overwhelmed by your generosity. As we wrote last week, our Outreach Services has received a \$15,000 grant to go toward our work and especially toward our educational support programs. This grant is funded by the Catholic Charities Appeal.

Normally we would be placing pledge cards in the pews this time of year to help to raise funds for this appeal. The Catholic Charities Appeal helps a large number of organizations throughout our Archdiocese in the areas of education, social services, evangelization and parish life, local mission activities, and clergy support.

A WORD OF HOPE

This past Tuesday, I sat down to begin my work from home when I received a message from one of our priests that our website was down. While it threw a wrench in my plans for the day, I did not think it would be too big of a deal. I prayed a prayer to St. Isidore, the patron saint of the internet, sent in a message to the company that hosts our website, and went back to working on some other things.

About an hour later, we realized that it was not only the website that was down, but our email too. Technology is great until it stops working, isn't it? As a communications person, this meant that the only way I could communicate with our beloved parishioners was through our Facebook page. I felt stuck and confused about how to do my job in this situation. (If you go back and look at our Facebook page, you'll notice that there were more posts than usual on Tuesday.)

One of the main announcements that I had wanted to communicate throughout our parish was that Pope Francis had asked all of us to pray, fast, and do works of charity for an end to the Coronavirus pandemic this past Thursday. I put together a video to help get the word out (did you know that St. Agnes is on YouTube?) and spent a decent amount of time reflecting on what this invitation from the Holy Father really meant and why it was so important for us to join him in prayer and penance.

The reality is, our website and email going down unexpectedly felt like just another one of those things, something else to add to the list of things that have not gone as we wanted them to go in the past few months. Confirmation, First Communion, and the reception of our candidates and elect into full communion with the Church have been postponed. Weddings, Baptisms, and funerals look much different if we even have them at all. We all miss having Mass and going to Communion.

This is why Pope Francis has asked us to join him in prayer, fasting, and works of charity. A few months ago, our current situation was unimaginable. But nothing has happened in this time that God has not foreseen from all eternity. We may feel surprised, frustrated, or caught off guard, but our Lord is not. The way and path to peace in this time is not by insisting that things go back to normal but instead to yield to God's will as He has revealed it in our current situation. When we put aside our own desires through prayer, fasting, and works of charity, we acknowledge that we do not know what is best for ourselves but that we trust that God does. This can be painful and scary, but truly there is nothing better than belonging totally to Him.

I began my ministry here at St. Agnes on the day that the Archbishop announced the suspension of public Masses. Having heard what a big, vibrant, and active parish St. Agnes is, it is strange to me that when I think of our church building, I picture it completely empty with only a few cameras set up. I look forward to the day when I can see our church filled and meet all of you with great joy and anticipation. But until then, we are united in prayer and rest safely in the hands of our loving Father.
