

COVID UPDATES

In keeping with the latest CDC, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and Archdiocesan guidelines for the relaxation of COVID-19 pandemic restrictions people no longer need to wear face coverings/masks in church if fully vaccinated. All building distancing and capacity restrictions have also been lifted so every pew may now be used.

The faithful continue to be dispensed by Archbishop Perez from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation until further notice. Live stream services will continue at this time for Mass and other sacramental celebrations and devotions.

The following practices will be in place at our parish beginning June 13th:

Daily Mass will be celebrated in the chapel.

There will be four stations across the front of the church for receiving Holy Communion in the hand or on the tongue. People will begin from the back of the church and walk up the side aisles to one of the Communion ministers and return to your pew by the center aisle.

There will be the procession of Gifts during the Offertory. Holy Water will be restored to the fonts and there will be regular cleaning.
