ADVENT IS UPON US! Expectant and Jubilant waiting on the Lord's birth is here! As I mentioned to you, I always believed that every day of our lives should be ADVENT! May this season of hope continue to bless us with AN EXPECTANT FAITH!

THE CHURCH WANTS TO HEAR YOU! His Holiness Pope Francis has called for all the Bishops of the world to come to Rome for a SYNOD in 2023. It is entitled "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission". In simple terms, Synod is "journeying together" to help her (Mother Church) to live in communion, to achieve participation, to open Herself to mission. It is in this light that we NEED to come together as a parish in a "listening session", the second one to be held on **Saturday, December 4, 2021 at 8:00am to 9:30am.**

So, what happens in our coming together? The Vatican has come up with 5 topics that we need to discuss. These are the following:

1. Companions on the Journey

- In the Church and in society, we are side by side on the same road.
- Who are those who "walk together"?
- Who are those who seem further apart?

2. Listening

- We need to have an open mind and open heart without prejudice.
- How is God speaking to us through voices we sometimes ignore, especially people who experience poverty, marginalization, or social exclusion?
- How are the laity listened to, especially women and young people?
- What facilitates or inhibits our listening?
- How well do we listen to those on the peripheries?

3. Celebration

- "Walking together" is only possible if it is based on communal listening to the Word and the celebration of the Eucharist.
- How do prayer and liturgical celebrations actually inspire and guide our common life and mission in our community?
- How do we promote the active participation of all the faithful in the liturgy?

4. Dialogue in Church and Society

- Dialogue** requires perseverance and patience, but it also enables mutual understanding.
- To what extent do diverse peoples in our community come together for dialogue?
- What are the places and means of dialogue within our local Church?
- What particular issues in the Church and society do we need to pay more attention to?
- How does the Church dialogue with and learn from other sectors of society: the spheres of politics, economics, culture, civil society, and people who live in poverty?

5. Discerning and Deciding

- In a synodal style, we make decisions through discernment of what the Holy Spirit is saying through our whole community.
- What methods and processes do we use in decision making?
- How can they be improved? How do we promote participation in decision making within hierarchical structures? Do our decision-making methods help us to listen to the whole People of God?
- Do our decision making methods help us to listen to the whole People of God? What tools and procedures do we use to promote transparency and accountability? How can we grow in communal discernment?
