OUR MARCHING ORDERS! "GO AND MAKE **DISCIPLES OF ALL MEN...**" Many understand that the work of evangelization largely depend upon the work of priests. NOT SO! It is the mission of ALL! When confronted with this truth, people argue that they are neither trained nor equipped for the task without realizing that it has been happening all of our lives.

From the moment we are born, our parents started us off immediately by showering us with LOVE and, thus, begin our training in being loved and loving in return. Certain disciplines follow: listening, understanding authority, passion, drive, etc. All these we will need to understand ourselves and others giving us a deeper insight to the human psyche in pursuit of bringing the GOOD NEWS OF SALVATION.

As I write this, our ship just entered Endicott Arm in Alaska. You can just imagine the view that is just outside my cabin window. The naturist on board giving a talk about the area quoted the poet Thoreau who wrote that the magnificence of the mountains was through the relentless work of the SNOWFLAKE that through the years of its constant presence has shaped, reshaped and tamed the landscape. It led me to think that as workers for the Lord, there is no act too small or deemed too inconsequential if we simply allow ourselves to be wonderfully used by God. I am eternally grateful that I did answer God's call and allowed myself to be sent to wherever He thought I may be of some use. In the time I have spent as a priest, I have lost people close to me. I lost my dear grandmother who spent a majority of her younger years caring for me. Not too long ago, I lost two of my closest friends due to Covid in Tucson - Aida Short, who was a Tucson Mom to me, and Louie Munoz, who not only cut my hair and made me look "human" but had become a friend – both had always been on hand to help me with whatever I needed. Then, I lost both my parents within 4 months from each other. Though painful, I must go through it knowing that they will always be in my heart. I lost many others in the Philippines – relatives, former Travel Industry colleagues and many others whom I had the privilege of having offered Zoom masses even at odd hours of the night and very early mornings. While the task was difficult, I am finally allowed to minister to my family and friends on the other side of the world.

My family also has seen the arrival of the next generation of my very close knit family. My niece Angela and her husband Karl, gifted us with 2 bright boys. My brother's 2 daughters, Adrienne and Rene, gave us our first great (continued)

niece – Jacqueline, while Paige and Jay gave us Julius and we await another girl in a few months. Next year, a nephew, Gio will wed Clarisse, God willing, with me as the celebrant. When thinking about their presence and all the activities, it reminds me that LIFE does indeed continue – whether we like it or not. So.... Better like it, participate in it....and simply enjoy it. This is called LIFE!

Today, God continues to bless me with so much. As I keep on telling my friends, GOD REALLY LOVES ME! And to all of you...THANK YOU...for the privilege and the opportunity to serve God and His people.
