What "unclean spirits" do we have in us? The Gospel this Sunday is a most interesting one – perhaps it is because we never think that we have "unclean spirits" in us. Heaven forbid! However, if we search our heart of hearts, we will find that there are quite a few of these that we need to render to the Lord for a permanent removal. Consider envy, doubt, impatience, lack of perseverance, laziness, jealousy, bitterness, arrogance, pride and the list simply continues. Sadly, since we do not recognize these as "unclean spirits", these remain in our hearts and "rears its ugly head" in our lives.

How do we deal with it? First of all, let us admit to ourselves that we have this problem. As has been said constantly, a solution will only be possible if we admit that it is something that must be dealt with.
