

The Easter Bunny has been very busy preparing hundreds and hundreds of eggs lovingly stuffed with candy, chocolate and MONEY! Among the eggs is a special one with a \$50.00 bill in it! Come and enjoy this time honored tradition. It will be lots of fun for the children, parents and even grandparents!

The Proper Way to Receive the Eucharist: Canon Law prescribes 2 ways by which the faithful can receive the Eucharist – by the tongue or by the hand – both with utmost reverence. In the 15 years of my priesthood, I have noted that there are still a lot of people who do not know how to receive the Host properly. Here are some points to consider:

- Receiving by the tongue If you have decided to receive by the tongue, approach the priest or the Extraordinary Ministers of the Holy Eucharist (EM) by showing your intention. Some put their open hands forward and open their mouth at the same time. Approach at a respectable distance, open your mouth, STICK OUT YOUR TONGUE and wait for the EM to place the host on it. DO NOT CLOSE YOUR MOUTH BEFORE THE EM HAS PULLED BACK HIS/HER FINGERS.
 - Please do not receive the host by clamping it down with your lips. The host is to be placed securely on your tongue BEFORE YOU CLOSE YOUR MOUTH.
 - O Some receive on the tongue while kneeling down and I don't have any problem with that; however, Fr. Douglas Martis, now Fr. Eusebius a renowned Liturgist, explains that while it is acceptable to do so, the faithful should be "one with those who are unable to do so" due to mobility problems, etc. Let us remember that a show of respect and piety is better shown in one's own way of life.
