TIMES OF REFRESHING Fr. Ricky V. Ordóñez

What it means to receive God's Divine Mercy! We always hear about God's Divine Mercy at mass, but do we truly know how to receive it? Many know about it but don't quite feel receiving it. Why? Let's try and figure this out!

First of all, why do we need it? Simply put, **WE ARE SINNERS! ALL OF US!** So, what makes our acts a sin? Since I am addressing us Catholics, I shall presume that by virtue of our Church participation and having been brought up by our parents and living under a free and democratic country, we have a fairly good idea of the differences between GOOD and EVIL. Yet, we chose EVIL – and as I have constantly reminded all of us – it is our preference of what is **convenient** versus having to put in more effort and do **what is right**. In my mind, it is a combination of lack of conviction and laziness! Ouch!!!!

Well, Jesus continues to reach out to us through many ways to **CONVICT** us, appeal to our innate goodness and inspire us to "get back on the road towards the right direction". This He offers us constantly and is referred to as DIVINE MERCY! It is an **ACT of GOD** in His desire to reunite His people (us) to Him even after we have sinned – YES! EVEN AFTER WE HAVE SINNED! But, also, with a prayer that we willingly turn our lives to Him with the **conviction (here's that word again!)** that we try our best to turn away from sin and make amends for our sinful actions.

I often refer to this conversion through the FOUR (4) R's!

- 1. Recognition of Sin Yes, we realize that we knew we were to commit a sin and did it anyway! It is a turning against God because of our rebellious nature. This is a very important step because if we don't recognize (or refuse to) having sinned then there is no conviction (Oh my! There's that word again!) and we simply keep on doing the wrong things.
- 2. Repentance of Sin We need to feel sorry for our sinfulness! Yup, this is a must. People who repent of their sins will naturally seek to make changes. This has to be an active ingredient in our quest to remove ("extricate" is more appropriate word, I think) ourselves from the "slippery slope" towards a sinful life. Indeed, feeling remorse for a sinful act will lead us toward the next step.
- 3. Reconciliation Having recognized and repented of our sinfulness, we move to a more proactive stance by seeking to reconcile ourselves with God and the People whom we have hurt. This is where we encounter Jesus in our thoughts, our hearts and in the Confessional! To know that God is willing to forgive us is a wonderful feeling; but to hear the words "...Your sins are forgiven. Go and sin no more!" is the human manifestation of God's love and mercy! Then, what? Then, we go and "make things right"!

4. Restitution – Congratulations! You have figured out that what you did was sinful which led you to a feeling of remorse and repentance. Feeling all these led you to a desire to reconcile with God and receive His mercy and having done so, you are now ready to make things right. How to do it? It may come in many forms – i.e. personally apologize, return things taken, fix things broken and above all, change the ATTITUDE and STRENGTHEN THE FAITH!
