TIMES OF REFRESHING

Why do we make Bad choices? In our First Reading today, the Apostle Peter speaks about the sad choice that people made by freeing Barrabas instead of Jesus. Towards the end, he surmises that they did it out of ignorance. Personally, when I know I've bungled up, I almost always trace it to a hasty decision and born out of ignorance. I may have regretted it, but now I am faced with having to put in more effort to make corrections. Perhaps we should put in more effort in trying to ensure that we should make INFORMED DECISIONS – rather than hastily and, often, foolishly made ones.

In hindsight, I recall having questioned why it took my parents longer to respond to my requests. Now, as an old man, I realize why – they simply put in more thought into making that decision – not for their own sake but how their decisions would affect me, them, the family, etc. I do thank the Lord for giving them that wisdom which has guided our family through.

Today, I am always bothered by some of the incredibly thoughtless actions of many people – young and old. For the young, I fear that they don't see how their actions can be so destructive to them – and how it can bring so much grief to their parents. For the older ones, often enough, we work with our – sometimes misplaced – sensitivities when we put more “color” to situations than what it contains. Thus, we are easily “hurt” by situations that we, ourselves, may have blown out of proportion. Of course, all these decisions (i.e. choices) are often made at the spur of the moment egged by perceived “bruised egos”.



Our Walking With Moms ministry is gearing up for another Baby Drive in May. This time collections will benefit the Christ Child Society of Tucson, who donate layette boxes to moms with new-borns. We're asking parishioners to donate only size 0-3 onesies and sleepers as well as hooded bath towels and washcloths. A baby crib will be set up near St Joseph for donations the first 2 weeks in May.
