TIMES OF REFRESHING Fr. Ricky V. Ordóñez

WE ARE ALL SHEPHERDS TO OUR FLOCK. BUT, ARE WE "GOOD"? Today we celebrate GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY – a moment for us to reflect on how we care for our flock. In order to begin our reflection, let's figure out what our flock is to us. Answer? Everything! It consists of members of our families – individually and collectively. Beyond them, we find ourselves being part of a greater "family" of co-workers, friends for whom we also show concern and care. Yes, we should consider them part of our flock!

Now that we have figured out the scope of our FLOCK, let's see how we can be "good" to them by first finding out our motivation for them to succeed – LOVE! Therefore, let's ask ourselves, "What should I do to ensure their good health (physical, mental, emotional, SPIRITUAL, etc.)?" Right? How? Let's go!

In our day and age, many tend to think that being "good" means that we accede to every wish and demand that people make of us. Inwardly we may want to see that everyone get what they want; however, what if we figure out that what they want may not be good for them? Often I struggle with this thought and sometimes I have to go through the more difficult path – to say "NO" when I have to. Yet if we truly love our "flock", then we need to do what is in their best interest. In essence, this is how to be "GOOD". Some kind of "tough love" – if it is necessary!

Annual Catholic Appeal Update: As of this writing, we have reached 70+% of our goal. Let's continue to pray about our participation in what our Diocese needs to fund.

THE HEART AND ART OF GIVING FEED-**BACK!** I love feeding birds! I finally figured this out when I review pictures I have taken after a trip and I always believed that I was doing the birds a favor when I fed them. When I was pastor in Payson, AZ, I would go to the little lake in town and would bring some stale bread to feed the migratory birds and ducks. One time, as I was feeding them, an older gentleman approached me and said that I shouldn't be doing that as it wasn't natural and it would deter them to find sustenance from nature. Immediately, I saw the logic and stopped. And then the clincher came as he continued, "You people....!" followed with very condescending and hurtful words. He didn't have to say all of that as I had shown understanding to what he was saying. For me, while it was a lesson learned did it have to come with an unnecessary "bitter pill to swallow"?

We receive letters of complaint from parishioners and it can be about anything - our homilies are long, our English isn't good enough, the music is bad, the sound system is bad, some lights are busted, our accents cannot be understood, we are not **as good as our predecessors**, they didn't agree with what we said (mostly they didn't understand what was meant), etc. and WE are the cause why there are less people coming to church. Furthermore, we are constantly told that Ss. Peter and Paul Parish is not what it used to be. The letters are mostly unsigned and come from people who claim to have been parishioners for 40 years or so and mostly with threats of leaving the parish. Do they honestly believe that all these comments would inspire and encourage us to do better? We are also human beings – who get hurt, who at times question our own abilities, who struggle and try to adapt to the culture of a country very much different from ours and more. Yet, we willingly left our families. friends, culture and all the comforts of our homes to come to the United States and serve the Church -YOU! And, yes, we are not perfect! And, yes, we have a lot more to learn, but we stay - year in and year out – hoping that, someday, we can do better and are "good enough" for the people we serve in our parish.

Giving FEEDBACK is very important, but shouldn't it be done in a spirit of LOVE and COMPASSION leading to inspiration and encouragement? My late grandmother would always admonish us, "It is not what you say, but how you say it." Do we want positive results? Then, let us choose our words wisely.

This we pray through Christ our Lord.


