

ABSOLUTE BEAUTY IN GOD'S HANDS - Many years ago I attended a Bonsai exhibition with a real "Master" of this Japanese art of growing and beautifying miniature trees. What amazed me was that he started by taking this twisted remnant of what may have been a healthy tree that had since seen better days. In my opinion, it did look like it was a prime candidate for the trash heap. But, the "Master", as he was called, cleaned, pruned and shaped it, thereafter, he prepared the ceramic pot filled with an interesting mix of soil, rock and other materials. He twisted wires on its trunk to hold it in place to create the rugged character of old trees and continued on to twist and turn branches until it began to show a magnificent profile. His skillful hands and fingers snipped and shaped leaves, broke off dead branches and scraped bark. By the end of the exhibition, all were astounded as what it had become - a true work of art and he was just beginning. Months later, after more care, pruning, twisting and stretching, all the participants were shown its present picture - a healthy, lush, natural tree filled with green leaves and luscious flowers.

I can't help but feel that this is what God is doing to us — in His hands, we are fished out of the sad situations we are confined, pruned, twisted, turned and stretched. The more we cooperate, the more we get closer to how God wants us to look like. If we refuse and keep on resisting God's skillful hands, we will break, wither and, eventually, die. Let's just trust THE Master — our Lord and savior Jesus Christ, shall we?
