TIMES OF REFRESHING Fr. Ricky V. Ordóñez

TRUE NOURISHMENT! People have asked me if I have been to one of the buffets in the casino. Yes, I have and I have come to the opinion that I really don't need all that food! But, I am human, too! There are times when I feel that my eyes need to be "filled" with a vision of an abundance of food. "Vanity and Greed!" my conscience screams! But only after I have come back to my senses when I can hardly breathe after stuffing myself.

Vanity – because I would like to believe that all that food is for "ME" – all mine for the taking – and I can have as much as I want. Greed – because my ego tells me that I have the means to take myself way beyond what is simply needed because I want to be assured that I have gotten my money's worth and more. Oh me, oh my! In the end, all I get is indigestion and regret as I scramble for some TUMS!

Sadly, most of us fall into this trap of not realizing that it is not the kind of "buffet" that we should seek to give us TRUE NOURISHMENT. Think of it this way! All that excess that I illustrated above is caused by an ego that always craves to be satiated. What got us to overeat or overindulge were not our stomachs, it was our brains that perceived a need way beyond its capacity. This is a sign of our brokenness when we have not realized that there is no need to do it in excess in order to be "happy".

Food is only one of those "needs" that cries out to be constantly filled. There's the need to accumulate money, clothes, shoes, etc. etc. Please, may I invite all of us to open our cabinets and have a look at what we have accumulated? Now, do we really need all of these or are they only there to remind us that we have them? A rich man who already owns a fleet of luxury cars visited a Rolls Royce dealership and was looking at the latest model. He told the sales person that he already owned several of them. When asked why he wanted another one, he replied, "Because I can!" Doesn't that scream.... "EGO running wild!"?

Then, what is 'TRUE NOURISHMENT'? To follow Jesus Christ closely is the one action we can take to receive what we truly need. It is in knowing Him that brings us to a reality that we don't need to do things in excess. Why, because "...my God has provided me with all of my needs according to His riches and glory!"
