TIMES OF REFRESHING Fr. Ricky V. Ordóñez

THE POWER TO FORGIVE! Very recently, I had to revisit what I truly think about *Forgiveness* – whether it had be relegated to mere lip service or truly felt in my heart, understood by my mind and followed by the action to do so. As I pondered on it, I had to take in what Jesus said about forgiving "not just seven times but seventy times seven". However, the human in me also wanted "satisfaction" - perhaps, even just a smidgen of "vengeance" – and then a "voice", not Jesus', but that of my departed parents. There were nights of having mental and heartfelt conversations with what I know would have been their thoughts as shared with me throughout my life. "To forgive those who have wronged you is a decision borne solely by you but always motivated by the forgiveness that you received from God." These were words that our Dad and Mom would always remind my siblings and I that made Jesus' words more real and relevant.

Indeed, the **POWER TO FORGIVE** has been granted to us by God who has always been so willing to forgive us. It is our own selfish egos that make us feel that we are entitled to desire "satisfaction" and "yes, even just a smidgen of vengeance". Instead, let us think about how we can all benefit from having RECONCILIATION as a mutual motivation rather than the feeling of "victory and vengeance" only from one side.

If there is one thing that I have learned, to withhold forgiveness is terribly EXHAUSTING!

THE CATASTROPHE OF "BLAME" The past week has seen many of us concerned about the fires in Los Angeles. Interspersed with stories of devastation, sorrow, grief and loss is the proverbial "blame game". Immediately, much needed energy that could have been focused on fire prevention and relief efforts are now trained on pinning the blame on State and City government officials. In my mind, will blaming them put a stop to the fire? Perhaps we should allow them to do what they need to do and revisit this topic when further threats have ended.

As always, many need to pin the blame on someone else? No one takes responsibility. We have been warned for decades about the effects of Global Warming caused by pollution and the gross misuse of nature. Private sector groups have spoken out. Governments have spoken out. The Pope has spoken out. But, what did they get? Criticism and even ridicule has been thrown at them by many. For us, the majority, did we listen? And if we did, how did we respond? Or did we simply remain silent? Sadly, we only react once tragedy hits us – but for as long as we feel we are not directly affected – we remain silent. Ouch! This is the truth, isn't it?
