

TIMES OF REFRESHING Fr. Ricky V. Ordóñez

The main ingredient in EVANGELIZATION! What did the Lord mean when He said, "Go out into the world and bring the GOOD NEWS of salvation."? First of all, He has "deputized" all of us to be a part of a worldwide movement to get to know HIM – who He is, what He says and how we should go about doing it. Secondly, if we are to be believed, then we should **PRACTICE WHAT WE PREACH!** It is our personal WITNESS-ING that gives credence to what we profess to be true.

Let's go "FISHING"! I was never a fisherman; but, I have many friends who simply live by it. They constantly talk about using the kind of rods, the bait, the line, their favorite fishing spots and just the right season to ensure a good catch. Interestingly enough, if we are to catch "MEN" - those with priestly vocations - we should consider the same things. The family creates a good "breeding ground" when from a young age; a child is exposed to the goodness of God and is encouraged to make a connection with the divine. From then onward, it is a collaboration between with the Church that makes a "catch" possible.

What do we have in the Diocese of Tucson? Many years ago, I made a study on the composition of the priests serving in the Diocese of Tucson and found that over 60 % are foreign born – myself included. I would imagine that there would be a much larger percentage by now. Today, aside from those from the United States, our presbyterate (that's what we call the roster of priests) is composed of priests from Mexico, Philippines, Nigeria, Congo, Ghana, Ireland, Vietnam, etc.

While we bring our own "gifts" to the church in the United States, it continues to become a challenge for us to get to know the people we serve. In the almost 22 years of being a resident, and now a citizen, I still continue to learn and understand the reality of American culture. We realize that we still speak with our own accents and our vocabulary (choice of words) may still be different, etc. However, one thing I know, is that we are willing to bring the "best that we have" in service to God and His people. As people say, "We may not have gotten it yet, but we will continue to learn!"
