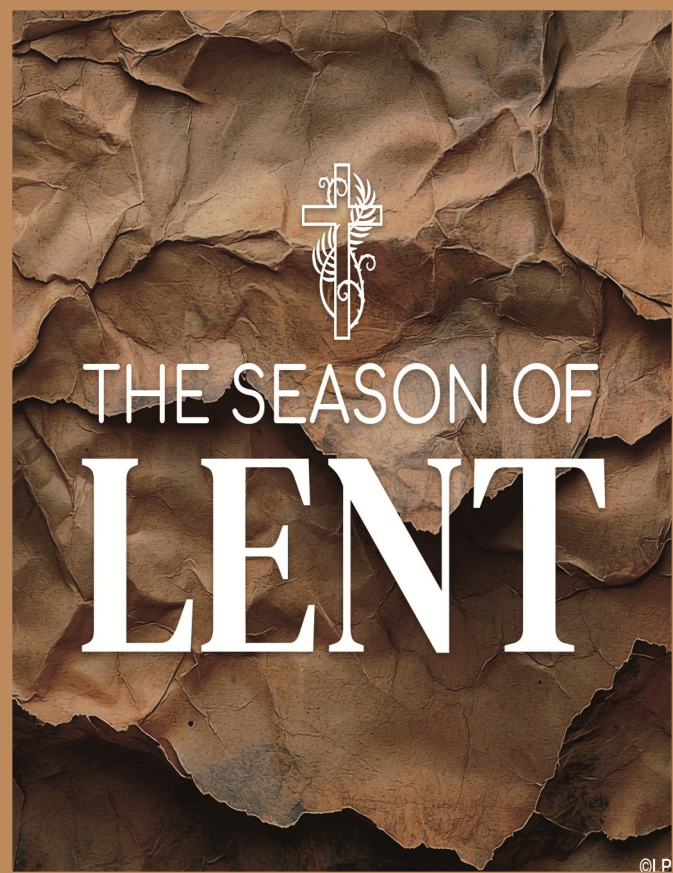

TIMES OF REFRESHING

Lenten Obligations. As fast as Christmas and the New Year have come and gone, we now enter into the Lenten season. So let us review what we need to do to prepare ourselves during this time of reflection, meditation, liturgy, sacraments etc.

- **Ash Wednesday** – This day is **NOT** a Holy Day of obligation; however, it is a day of holy day of invitation – a day of **FASTING** and **ABSTAINING FROM EATING MEAT**.
 - * Here are the rules according to the USCCB: ***“For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.”***
 - * Mass times on this day will be at 7am, 12 noon and 5:30PM. Ashes will be imposed after mass.
- **Every Friday of Lent** – It is **obligatory** for all Catholics to abstain from eating meat every Friday of Lent. (Please see above for the guidelines above.)
 - * It is recommended to attend at least one of the **Stations of the Cross every Friday. This will be held at Ss. Peter and Paul Church at 6pm.**
 - * The Knights of Columbus will be offering Soup and Bread every Friday of Lent from 5pm to 6pm.
- **Sacrament of Reconciliation** – It is recommended that all Catholics come to confession at least twice a year – during Lent and Advent. Confessions are heard at Ss. Peter and Paul every Saturday from 10:30 am to 11:30 am and 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm. **Our Lenten Penance service will be held on March 12 at 5 PM.**
- **Palm Sunday Mass** – April 13, 2025 – Regular Sunday Mass schedules
- **Holy Thursday** – April 17, 2025 – Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7PM.
- **Good Friday** – April 18, 2025 – Good Friday Liturgy at 12:30PM
 - * ***It is obligatory for all Catholics concerned to observe FASTING AND ABSTAINING FROM EATING MEAT ON THIS DAY. (Please see the guidelines above.)***

- **Easter Vigil** – April 19, 2025 – Easter Vigil Liturgy at 7PM
- **Easter Sunday** – April 20, 2025 – Regular Sunday Mass schedules.
- **The GREAT EASTER EGG HUNT** - 10:30AM

Philippians 2:14-15 – Do everything without complaining or arguing, so that you may become blameless and pure...

1 Thessalonians 5:18 – Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 4:31 – Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice.

Ephesians 4:32 – Be kind and compassionate to one another forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you
