#### TIMES OF REFRESHING Fr. Ricky V. Ordóñez

#### "GOOD MORNING, FELLOW PRODIGAL CHIL-

**DREN!**" The parable of the Prodigal Son is perhaps one of my "all-time favorite" bible stories. Why? Because it totally resonates with me as it should with all of us. Let us ask ourselves, "How many times have we sinned against God? And how many times have we felt His forgiveness?" Yet how many times have we experienced the Lord restoring us?"

I've often told my own testimony how I strengthened my relationship with my Dad. You see, I grew up with my maternal grandparents whose culture was the exact opposite to my Dad's family. While I knew that my Dad loved me, he had such great difficulty showing it. When my relationship with the Lord had strengthened, I realized that my Dad and I were both getting older and someone had to make the "first move". So, I decided that I would do it! As a businessman in my 30's, I made my Dad the object of a very important "project study".

First, I had to figure out what would be our "common denominator" - sadly, I found out that we had become worlds apart. He loved golf, I didn't. He collected art, I didn't know much about it. He loved classical opera, I preferred R & B. He enjoyed talking about investments, I didn't. So, what did I do? First, I went to the golf pro shop and asked the sales person to explain to me the differences between a putter and a driver and all the other things that go with it. Then I visited the art gallery and learned about the upcoming artists that Dad would casually mention. I went to the Cultural Center and watched a couple of operas during the season. Finally, I sought out my banker and asked around about interest rates, investment opportunities, etc. In short, I did my homework.

Feeling equipped with what I needed, the next time I went home for a visit, I opened these topics with my Dad and thereafter, the "dam" of communication simply burst forth. Since that time, until his death many years later, we never ran out of something to talk about. In short, while I started to "walk towards my Dad, I found him RUNNING towards me!"

I feel that this is the same situation with us and God. In order for us to improve our relationship with Him, we have to do our "homework" – understand what he stands for, what he has been trying to teach us and where it is that he wants us to be. Once we give ourselves a chance to do this, we definitely will find that He simply has been awaiting our return to Him.

I really miss my Dad, but somehow, Jesus reminds me that he is just around like all fathers have been.

A number of boys never saw their fathers for days at a time, some not even for weeks. The average time father and son had alone together for an entire week was 7 and ½ minutes.
