TIMES OF REFRESHING

Are we so quick to condemn? I have always been fond of watching commentaries that involve the interpretation of the law. Perhaps, I should have been a lawyer, or at least, a Canon lawyer like my seminary professors once encouraged. Oftentimes, as priests, we are often faced with having to make quick decisions with limited information. A very dangerous situation, don't you think? Many years ago, I was deeply touched by a teaching from a much respected politician and I would like to summarize that with you in "bullet form".

- Firstly, information is given.
 - o Consider: Who gave the information? Is it from a credible source? Are there any glaring agendas to the informant's favor? Is it logical?
- Secondly, did we fully understand the information given?
 - Consider: Was the information given received "crystal clear"? If there was any doubt about what it meant, was there any clarification asked?
- Thirdly, having received and understood the information given, can we honestly say that we understand the ramifications of that new "knowledge"?
 - o Consider: What does this knowledge mean to me? How shall I react to it? Will it be a "game changer" in my life?
- Fourthly, in what may come out of it, is there room for compassion and reconciliation?
 - Consider: If there is room for compassion, then we are called to go that direction. If there is none, it will simply leave us with anger, bitterness, resentment, etc. Therefore, the choice is ours! ALWAYS SEEK ROOM FOR COMPASSION. We will NEVER GO WRONG!
