TIMES OF REFRESHING

HOSSANA! HOSSANA! Palm Sunday commemorates Jesus' "triumphal" entry to Jerusalem and is mentioned in all the four gospels. Riding a donkey from the Mt. of Olives, Jesus is greeted by people who have heard about the miracles that has made Him famous. They waved branches (traditionally called "Palms") from trees in the neighborhood and laid their cloaks as a sign of welcome. Today, pilgrims make their way down a steep road passing through several holy sites – "Dominus Flevit" a small church overlooking the city which commemorates the place where "Jesus wept" for the city. It was designed in a form of an "upturned tear" the altar of which is before a panoramic window that shows the old walls of the city. Further down is the Russian Orthodox Church with its gleaming golden onion shaped domes. Finally, at the bottom of the road is the Garden of Gethsemane – with its thousand year old olive trees beside the magnificent Church of All Nations.

This particular church is, perhaps, one of the most beautiful designed by the Italian architect Barluzzi. Its façade is a traditional Roman triumphal arch that leads to the church's dark interior, its columns mimicking the tree trunks that would remind one of the Garden of Gethsemane of old. In front of the altar is bare rock, fully lit and reminiscent of where Jesus experienced the "agony in the garden".

This is the setting by which we commemorate the events of Palm Sunday. Today, we realize that the very same people who welcomed the Lord were the same ones who shouted, "Crucify him! Crucify him!" How ironic, if not hypocritical! But, isn't this our story! Many call Jesus, "Lord!" but choose to compromise His teaching to suit personal tastes, agendas and inclinations. Isn't this ironic and hypocritical?
