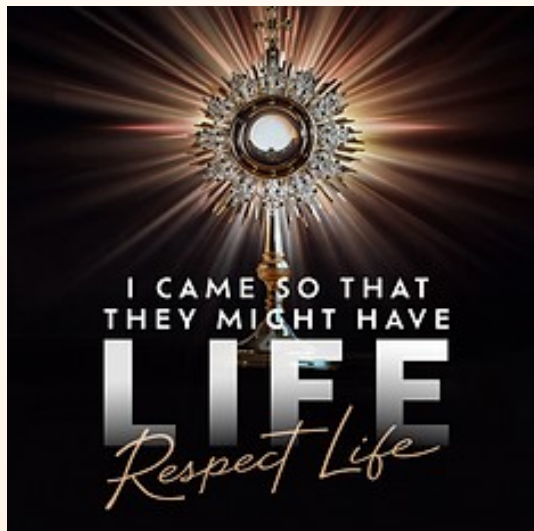

Respect Life Month – 2025

Since January of 2023, the Respect Life ministry members have “walked with” 16 women, meeting with them in their homes and providing them with resources, as well as emotional, spiritual, and material support. We walked with some of these moms for several months, making multiple visits to encourage and assist them, to pray with them and for them. With generous donations from SS Peter and Paul parishioners and Christ Child Society, we have been able to greet the women with a little Love Box and bag containing small necessities for new moms and babies. We celebrated one mom’s decision to choose life for her unborn child with a baby shower. We “showered” another family when their baby finally came home from the NICU. Additionally, we have given away a gently used crib, pack-n-play, and three strollers as well as many diapers, wipes, formula, and baby toys. We humbly ask you for your continued prayers for these moms and those that may cross our paths in the future.
