



TIMES OF REFRESHING

STARTING THE YEAR RIGHT! Disposition and priorities are 2 words that primarily come to mind at the beginning of the year. One has to have the proper mindset of FAITH, POSITIVITY, PERSEVERANCE and HUMILITY in order to have the right disposition in pursuing our goals.

FAITH – Let us be guided by what the Lord has constantly been asking us to do as we have constantly heard in the 2 GREATEST COMMANDMENTS! 1) Loving God (which includes listening and obeying HIM). *‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’*(Mt. 22:37) 2) Loving each other (which includes FORGIVING) *‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’* (Mt. 22:39)

POSITIVITY – Let’s begin the year knowing that with God **“NOTHING IS IMPOSSIBLE”** and when **“GOD IS WITH US, WHO CAN BE AGAINST US!”** We should let go of our doubts and fears about pursuing our goals. Thus, we should have a POSITIVE attitude instead of a defeatist one.

How much more direct could God be in setting us on the road to salvation with this statement? So, the question remains, “How intently are we listening to Jesus?”
