



IN UNITY THERE IS REAL STRENGTH! There's a story about a dying father who was so concerned about his constantly bickering sons. As he lay on his deathbed, he asked God "Lord, what can I do to stop my sons from fighting one another?" The Lord inspired him to call his sons and gave each of them a stick. He asked each one of them to break the stick and they promptly did so with much ease. Thereupon, he gathered all the broken sticks, put tied it together and asked them, "Here, break these sticks!" Each one of them tried and none of them with all their strength can do so. The father then said, "With you alone, you can break; but, with all of you together you are strong and will not break! See to it that you are always united with 'one heart and one mind'. Pray together, listen together, love one another and forgive one another." This was the best legacy that the dying man left his sons.

LET US PRAY TOGETHER! Praying together bring us so much strength in knowing that we are not alone in our faith. It is in sharing our worship that we realize that we belong to one family – a true family in Christ! As we come to church every week, we recognize the same people coming week after week and when we do, somehow we feel "All is well".

LET US LISTEN TOGETHER! Listening to the Word of God together allows us to be on the same trajectory with our spiritual family. The Lord speaks to us in ways that are different yet the same – each one hearing what we need to hear; yet, with the same words spoken. This is the miracle of the Word of God! LET US LOVE AND FORGIVE ONE ANOTHER! The "glue" that keeps us unified is LOVE! First of all, it is the LOVE OF GOD that has brought us all together. Love has always been the main motivating factor in everything we do. Then, there is "forgiving each other" that keeps us focused on maintaining the presence of peace in our lives.
