Small Group Discussion Guide

Our recommendation for small group discussion groups:

- ◇ Begin with the Eucharistic Revival Prayer
- ◇ Introduce one another
- ◇ If individuals have not watched the chat, then provide an opportunity for the group to watch the monthly chat together
- ◇ Begin the discussion by following the provided reflection questions.
- ◇ First give each person an opportunity to respond to the questions.
- ◇ Once everyone has had a chance to respond, open up for a large group discussion.
- ◇ Close with a closing prayer or the Eucharistic Revival Prayer.
