

## Rules for Application

1.	<ul> <li>Qualified applicants are:</li> <li>□ Practicing Catholic according to the five (5) precepts of the Catholic Church,</li> <li>□ Osage on the Indian Rolls in Pawhuska,</li> <li>□ Enrolled in 12 hours for undergraduate studies maintaining a minimum of 2.5 GPA OR enrolled in 6 hours for graduate studies maintaining a minimum of 3.0 GPA.</li> </ul>
2.	Qualified applicants will complete the application with <u>Pastor signature</u> by <b>April 15<sup>th</sup></b> with:  ☐ Copies of CDIB (front and back), ☐ Copies of W2 or 1040A (parent/guardian's if self-supporting), ☐ Appraisal Form and/or Letter of Recommendation, ☐ Certification Form, ☐ and Official Transcripts including fall semester grades.
3.	Scholarship recipients will:  Take the required 12 hours for undergraduate or 6 hours for graduate studies,  Maintain a 2.50 undergrad or 3.0 graduate GPA (3-year average),  Provide fall grades and spring enrollment for spring disbursements
4.	<ul> <li>Scholarships are:</li> <li>Reviewed by the Scholarship Committee one time per year. All decisions are final.</li> <li>Awarded by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Tulsa on the basis of financial need and academic ability of members of the Osage Indian Tribe and Catholic Church.</li> <li>To be used at any accredited college or university for undergraduate or graduate studies.</li> <li>Withheld in the spring if fall grades and/or semester hours do not meet the aforementioned minimum standards.</li> <li>Renewable annually. The Renewal Form is due on April 15<sup>th</sup>.</li> </ul>
