



Rules for Application

1. Qualified applicants are:
 - ☐ Practicing Catholic according to the five (5) precepts of the Catholic Church,
 - ☐ Osage on the Indian Rolls in Pawhuska,
 - ☐ Enrolled as full-time status/semester in an accredited college, university, trade or vocational institution.
 - ☐ Maintaining a minimum of 2.5 GPA undergraduate, trade or vocational institutional GPA *OR* 3.0 graduate GPA.
2. Qualified applicants will complete the application with Pastor signature by **April 15th** with:
 - ☐ Copies of CDIB (front and back),
 - ☐ Copies of W2 or 1040A (parent/guardian's if self-supporting),
 - ☐ Appraisal Form and/or Letter of Recommendation,
 - ☐ Certification Form,
 - ☐ and Official Transcripts including fall semester grades.
3. Scholarship recipients will:
 - ☐ Enroll and take full-time status/semester in an accredited college, university, trade or vocational institution,
 - ☐ Maintain a 2.50 undergraduate, trade or vocational institutional GPA, or 3.0 graduate GPA,
 - ☐ Provide fall grades and spring enrollment for spring disbursements
4. Scholarships are:
 - Reviewed by the Scholarship Committee one time per year. All decisions are final.
 - Awarded by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Tulsa on the basis of financial need and academic ability of members of the Osage Indian Tribe and Catholic Church.
 - To be used at any accredited college, university, trade or vocational institution for undergraduate or graduate studies.
 - Withheld in the spring if fall grades and/or semester hours do not meet the aforementioned minimum standards.
 - Renewable annually. The Renewal Form is due on April 15th.
