FOFTH SUNDAY ON LENT

Dear Friends of Saint Anthony,

'Since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us, and persevere in running the race that lies before us, while keeping our eyes

fixed on Jesus, the leader and perfecter of faith."

Blessedness, holiness, is an "inside" job. While the Old Covenant was clear, and its law clear and true, even the standard by which people live in freedom, it is not "self-executing." Nor is it sufficient for right relationship with God and neighbor. In the only passage in the Old Testament where the "New Covenant" is explicitly promised, the remedy of the inward transformation Jesus accomplishes in his passion, death and resurrection for all who believe is implicitly promised by "writing it upon (our) hearts."

This new heart is what King David prays for and celebrates in the "Miserere," Psalm 51, the most famous of the penitential psalms. In it he experiences the paradox of the enormity of his sin and the super-abundant Mercy of God for him as a sinner. It is precisely this clarity that King David; the woman caught in adultery; the Good Thief; Saint Paul; and all honest people have about their true state that makes their encounter with God's mercy in Jesus so transformative.

Now that it is our turn, we can all have this life-changing experience in the sacrament of reconciliation, offered twice a day six days a week, and at our parish penance service on Spy Wednesday, March 27th at 7:00 PM.

Blessedness is an inside job, the fruit of a new heart! "God's vision still has its time, presses on to fulfillment, and will not disappoint!" Let us prav!

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday* are days of fast and abstinence (c. 1251). Everyone over 14 years of age is obliged to abstain from meat on those days. Only those over 18 and under 59 are obliged to fast (c. 1252).

Fasting is understood to mean taking just one meal in a day; however, some other nourishment may be taken at other times during the day.
