### ASCENSOON OF THE LORD

Dear Friends of Saint Anthony,

"Christ is risen from the dead, trampling over death by death! Come awake, come awake, come and rise up from the dead!"

Although we sing: "Christ is risen from the dead, trampling over death by death! Come awake, come awake, come and rise up from the dead!" don't we sing it half-heartedly at times, and only in Church, haunted by Dosto-yevsky's question: "Can a cultured man, a European of our days, believe, really believe, in the divinity of the Son of God, Jesus Christ?" The Solemnity of the Ascension is the perfect occasion to answer him "Yes!" no matter our race, creed, color, sex, religion, national origin, or anything that distracts us from our identity in Christ.

As Pope Francis says, we are not living in an "Era of Change" but a "Change of Era." So, "Abiding the Long Defeat: How to Evangelize Like a Hobbit in a Disenchanted Age"2, and becoming Jesus' "Presence in the Modern World"3 requires of us a passionate rejection of all the rejections of reality that are part and parcel of this moment in salvation history, and a confession of who, and whose we are, come what may. The Ascension provides us with the opportunity to say that by the Easter mystery, Jesus has changed my life, and by his being now both with me and in heaven, I can by grace judge the way forward clearly.

Pentecost, which we celebrate next weekend, is like the Feast of the Ascension activated, for when the Holy Spirit fell with "tongues of fire" on the Apostles it was like they were "already, but not yet" participating in Jesus' Easter victory! "The vision still has its time, presses on to fulfillment, and will not disappoint!"
