FOFTEENTH SUNDAY ON O.T.

Dear Friends of Saint Anthony,

"Since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us, and persevere in running the race that lies before us, while keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus,

the leader and perfecter of faith."

Today, as we celebrate the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time, and 8th Sunday of Pentecost, we are reminded, the more things change, the more they stay the same. God sends the prophets he calls, like Amos, not "professionals"! His instructions to the 12 Apostles are an echo of those to the 12 tribes as they crossed the Jordan in Joshua 3:4, total reliance on God, "for they had not gone this way before."

Now that it is our turn, Mark wants us to see the Apostles' mission, and our participation in it, as a new Exodus. Not just slavery to Pharaoh to the freedom of the Law, but beyond that. Jesus is the fulfillment of the Law, and more, the beginning of the Gospel. Talk about "We have not been this way before!"

As Saint Paul proclaims in today's Epistle, the "God and Father of Our Lord Jesus Christ, has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavens," so that we, imitating St. Anthony, might "keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, the leader and perfecter of faith" as we participate in God's work here in Little Rome, knowing "If the Lord does not build the house, in vain do its builders labor."

We "non-professional prophets" are equipped to go this new way, for "God's vision still has its time, presses on to fulfillment, and will not disappoint!" Let us pray!
