### **Strategic Planning**

### **Policy Formation**

Assist the Pastor and the Principal in developing policies for the school in conformity with policies of the Diocese and laws of the State of Indiana.

### **Public Relations and Marketing**

Develop and assist in implementing a plan for presenting a positive public image of the School and its Catholic identity, character, and mission.

### **Evaluation**

Determine whether the school is meeting academic goals, fulfilling strategic plans, and periodically administering anonymous surveys to school families and staff.
