- 2 – Lined 3x5 index cards*
- 1 – Clorox Wipes*

Students will have 1 inch binders for their math, 7 and 8 science classes. If students would like an additional 3 ring binder for ELA, Religion, and specials that is perfectly fine. Just having folders for their other classes would also be another great option.

You and your child can decide on what may be best for your student in terms of organization. We recommend **no** trapper keepers/zipper binders as we have lockers in the hallway now, and they will be able to go to their lockers in between classes. This will minimize the amount of items the students will need to bring to each class. We will be working with the students on how to effectively utilize their locker. Students will **not** need to purchase locks for their lockers.
