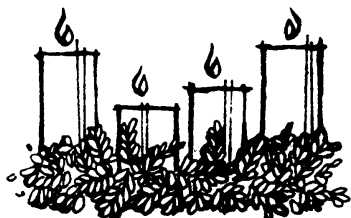

All are invited and encouraged to join Fr. Khanh for Daily Mass (check the Mass times on the schedule above).



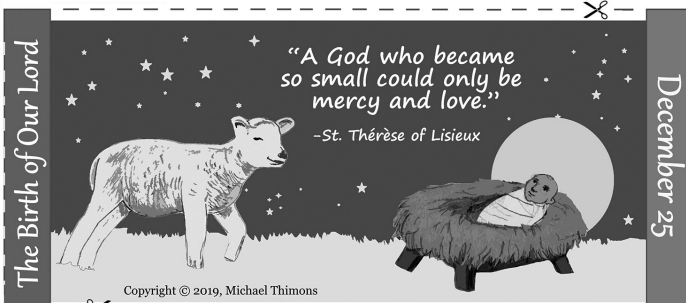
