DISCUSSIONS WITH DAVE...

Beginning June 19, 2022 on the Feast of Corpus Christi (Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ) our diocese and dioceses across the United States will begin a multi-year National Eucharistic Revival. The mission of this revival is to renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. There will be many opportunities for Catholics to immerse themselves in this revival at the diocesan level and here at Holy Trinity. The US Conference of Catholic Bishops has agreed on 5 strategic pillars for us to meditate and pray over. I will cover these 5 pillars over the coming weeks.

The first pillar is to foster encounters with Jesus through proclamation and experiences of Eucharistic devotion. As we contemplate our own Eucharistic devotion, I encourage you to seek outward ways you and your family can strengthen their relationship with our Eucharistic Lord. Each Monday, 6:30 pm - 8:30 pm, adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place as well as after the 8 am Mass on the first Saturday of the month.

Coming to Jesus who is exposed, visible and vulnerable on our Holy Altar opens our heart and minds in knowing His True Presence dwells amongst us. This period of silent sacredness is an escape from a noisy world which allows us an opportunity to look at Him and ask Him for wisdom, guidance, forgiveness, direction. To be present with Him and draw yourself closer to Him at a time when the world seeks distance from Him. To listen to Him in what He places on your heart and strengthen your relationship with Him in knowing how to respond. Countless miracles are attributed to those who watch and wait with our Lord. He is waiting for you to adore Him. Will you keep watch?
