Regarding Divine Mercy Sunday, Jesus told St. Faustina, "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain **COMPLETE FORGIVENESS OF SINS AND PUNISHMENT**."

The good news about this GREAT GRACE of Divine Mercy Sunday is that to receive it, you simply need to go to confession before or on the feast (during Lent will suffice), be in a state of grace (no mortal sin), receive Holy Communion with the intention of obtaining the promised grace, and venerate the image of Divine Mercy. (In addition, one should also do an act of mercy such as forgiving others, praying for others, or being merciful to your neighbor.)
