All meetings will still take place in the Shed.

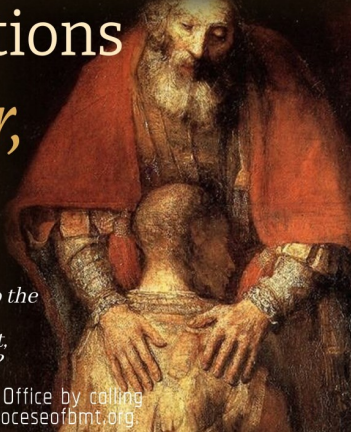
